Attached is the monthly report for the Massillon Fire Department for March, 2022.

The department responded to a total of 472 alarms during the month. This averages to 15.2 alarms per day. There were 131 fire alarms and/or public service calls, and 341 Rescue and EMS calls. There were no injuries due to fire.

On the 1st and 9th of the month, we conducted new hire interviews in preparation for hiring one Firefighter / Medic.

On the 3rd of the month, I attended the monthly LOGIC Board meeting.

On the 7th of the month, I attended a CrewForce setup meeting. CrewForce is an application through the county CAD (computer aided dispatch) that adds to dispatcher and response efficiency. Real time information updates, increased accuracy with unit status change times, and reduced radio traffic are a few of the benefits provided.

Also, on the 7th of the month, Autumn Parsons, a second grader at Whittier Elementary was recognized for winning an Ohio State Fire Marshal sponsored statewide fire safety poster contest.

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On the 9th and the 16th of the month, we met with John Picard to continue discussing design ideas on a potential renovation to Fire Station # 1.

On the 14th of the month, I attended the Ohio Fire Chiefs Association Legislative Committee meeting via zoom.

On the 18th of the month, Capt. Ganoë, Inspectors Canfora and Wagner, and I attended the State of the City / Awards breakfast. Capt. Dan Podlogar was awarded the Firefighter of the Year award.

On the 23rd of the month, I attended the RED Center Fire Operations meeting at Jackson Township Safety Center.

On the 29th of the month, Brittany Fleming and Allison Feters successfully completed their probationary period. They have proven to be valuable assets to the department and we look forward to great accomplishments from both.

Most of the month was spent preparing the new ladder truck for service. This included mounting equipment (completed at Sensible Products), in-service training with all personnel, driver training, and hose testing. The new truck has been well received by officers and firefighters with positive feedback on ease of operation and the increased capabilities provided to mitigate the different types of emergencies we are called to handle. I want to thank the Administration and City Council for their support and making this purchase possible.

- **Housing:** Full rehab project is nearly completed for a Massillon home owner. Three home-buyer projects are completed. We have a new home buyer expected to close sometime in the next couple weeks. Updated and continued contact with RPC regarding projects. We have continued interest in the down payment assistance program during this sellers' market. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of March I received 17 fair housing calls. A lot of calls have recently come in regarding folks looking for housing. We supply resources/contacts when we receive these calls. Many tenants called complaining about lack of repairs. Code enforcement assists with repair calls. We work together to make sure properties are registered as rentals. Several out of city calls were referred to Stark County for Assistance.
- **Community Development:** Applications are being reviewed and graded for potential block grant funding recipients. Two new furnaces were furnished to home owners with heat. Project under way for a home owner with outdated/unsafe electric. Another emergency application was sent to a longtime resident with a leaky roof. IDIS and department spread sheets are being updated. HMRP Applications were received during month of March, these will be reviewed. Qualifying home owners will be received check.
- **Administrative:** Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed.

Subject: Income Tax Monthly Report – March 2022

Date: April 5, 2022

The total income tax receipts posted for March 2022 was \$2,189,332.96. This amount is an increase from March 2021 of \$490,825.91 (+29%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2022 was \$6,560,399.97. Receipts posted for 2022 was an increase from 2021 of \$874,735.78 (+15%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 72% of all tax collections through the year of 2022. Individual income tax payments represent 10% of all tax collections through the year of 2022 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 18%.

Average monthly income for the three months of 2022 is \$2,186,799.99. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35.

Year to date refunds for 2022 was \$71,681.35 compared to refunds for 2021 of \$192,246.57. Refunds difference \$120,562.22 (more in refunds 2021 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 25.00% for the following accounts for 2022. Account percentages collected for the three months of 2022 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In March of 2022 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 96 traffic citations, this is 45 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 8 arrests for OVI, 5 less than were made in March of 2021. Radar citations for the month totaled 8; this was 31 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 63 traffic accidents during March. This was 31 less than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 42 property damage accidents, 7 injury accidents and no fatal accidents. There were 14 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 8 hit skip accidents, and 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was no motorcycle, bicycle or pedestrian accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 7 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 injury.

In March of 2022 there were 79 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 6 more than were towed in March of 2021. Of the above tows, 36 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 10 for traffic offenses of some type, 16 as a direct result of an arrest and 16 for parking violations. There were 1 misc. tows and 0 recovered stolen vehicle.

During the month of March 2022 the traffic officer mailed 20 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 14 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During March 2022, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 15 motor vehicles. Also during the month of March, the traffic officer issued or acted upon 20 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 16 parking citation and investigated 2 school bus violations.

As of the last day of March 2022 there were 45 motor vehicles sitting in the impound lots of Patriot and Reed's Towing Services and 3 vehicles in secure storage. Of the 48 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
