- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** We have two Full Rehabilitation. One has had city inspections. Our Regional inspector will provide the specifications for the Full Rehabilitation. One is still undergoing the inspection from our city officials. Once we have their reports we will send them to the Regional Inspector for him to complete the inspection and access if we can move forward to request appraisals.
- **Minor Repair:** None presently
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We have paperwork for a resident who needs a roof, we are working with him and his family because of compromised conditions he cannot be in the home when the roof is being replaced. He recently had another major surgery. We will have to start paperwork over to move forward. We have a resident who is requesting windows and doors, we have the verifications in place and have requested our Regional Inspector to provide specifications for windows and doors.
- **First time Homebuyer Assistance:** The First Time Homebuyer who missed the Pre-construction has finally received clearance and has a scheduled pre-construction meeting. We have a first-time home buyer who closed and now preparing for RRS to be done. The home one of our first time homebuyers wanted to purchase, did not qualify as a worthy purchase. The second First time home buyer came back with specifications to high so the sellers are repairing some of the items that would need to be repaired. We are requesting the Regional Inspector to inspect again to see if the home would qualify.

- **Housing:** Our department is currently working with two home owners for possible full rehabilitations. Requests for inspections have been submitted to regional inspector. RRS items are started for a homeowner that used home buyers' program. A second owners RRS project is bid out to contractors. We currently have an approved home buyer, and two new applicants being verified. We have updated and continued contact with RPC regarding projects. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger. We are in anticipation of our new program years funding, and will continue to assist as many homeowners/and homebuyers as possible.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of July I received 18 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. A lot of calls continue to come in for residents looking for rental property, we supply resources/contacts when we receive these calls. We also provide information to tenants on steps to take to escrow rent if necessary. The housing department participated in the Massillon Fun Fest this month. Turn out for this event was fantastic, we were able to provide a lot of information to Massillon residents, and answer questions as well.
- **Community Development:** We continue to do on-site monitoring of our 21' sub recipients. Budget for new program year is established. We look forward to new funding, and again assisting home owners, and Sub recipients. We have two approved emergency /minor repair recipients currently. We are anticipating a work specification for a roof repair from regional inspector, and are working toward sewer line repair for another home owner. IDIS and department spread sheets are continually updated.
- **Administrative:** Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. This month we ordered material/activities for Fun Fest .Preparation and updating of department brochures. Handle phone calls as received.

The total income tax receipts posted for August 2022 was \$1,852,366.35. This amount is an increase from August 2021 of \$125,122.33 (+7%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2022 was \$16,952,371.80. Receipts posted for 2022 was an increase from 2021 of \$1,240,235.28 (+8%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 70% of all tax collections through the year of 2022. Individual income tax payments represent 12% of all tax collections through the year of 2022 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 18%.

Average monthly income for the eight months of 2022 is \$2,119,046.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35.

Year to date refunds for 2022 was \$372,014.01 compared to refunds for 2021 of \$423,126.30. Refunds difference \$51,112.29 (more in refunds 2021 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 66.67% for the following accounts for 2022. Account percentages collected for the eight months of 2022 are as follows:

In August of 2022, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 66 traffic citations, 64 more traffic citations that was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 11 arrests for OVI, 5 more than was made in August of 2021. Radar Citations for the month totaled 3; this was 17 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 63 traffic accidents during August 2022. This was 14 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 47 property damage accidents, 6 injury accidents, and 20 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 9 hit skip accidents, and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was no pedestrian or bicycle, but 1 motorcycle accident. There were 5 commercial accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 7 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 0 reported injuries. There were 0 fatal accidents.

In August of 2022 there were 57 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 27 less than were towed in August of 2021. Of the above tows, 25 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 8 for traffic offenses of some type, 20 as a direct result of an arrest, and 13 for parking violations. There were 0 vehicles towed as stolen/recovered and 1 misc. tow.

During the month of August 2022 the traffic officer mailed 15 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 11 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During August 2022, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 11 motor vehicles. Also during the month of August, the traffic officer issued or took action on 20 warning notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court orders for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 17 parking citations and conducted 0 garbage truck inspections and investigated 0 school bus violation

As of the last day of August 2022 there were 42 motor vehicles sitting at the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 42 vehicles, several are waiting for court orders to dispose of them as well as 3 being in secured storage.
