- **Fair Housing Calls for the Month: Beverly 12, Anna 26**

## **Code Enforcement Involvement - Yes as needed**

### **Were any of them discrimination related? NO**

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** We have two Full Rehabilitation. We have received the Appraisal and notifying the homeowner that we are ready to proceed on the first Rehab. 2. We have received information that we will not be able to move forward on the second Rehabilitation, because of the amount that it would take to do it. The amount for both would exceed our limit.
- **Minor Repair:** We have a roof that is being done for a Massillon resident who is disabled and is complete to date. This second roof has been taken out of the projected Full Rehabilitation that are not able to do, due to the amount of work and expense. Therefore, modification to a Minor Repair roof only at this time. We have a resident who is requesting windows and doors, we have had the pre-construction meeting and as soon as the Contractor can get the doors and windows the work can begin.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We have paperwork for a resident who needs a roof, we are working with him and his family because of health compromised conditions he cannot be in the home when the roof is being replaced. He recently had another major surgery. Paperwork has been updated and the Regional Inspector has been notified to inspect the work needed. A resident in the city had a large sewer problem. We were able to work with Engineering, and Contractor to get the work done. This job is complete, the cement works is scheduled to be completed any day now. Another furnace emergency was denied, home co-owned by father who does not live in the home and back taxes.
- **First time Homebuyer Assistance:** We have a couple of homebuyers that are receiving their RRS repairs. One homebuyer who has been approved, we are waiting on the Regional Inspectors report as to whether the home is a worthy purchase. Another potential homebuyer has no purchase agreement in place yet. Another First Time Homebuyer was over income.

## **MONTHLY REPORT: October 2022**

**To:** Samantha Walters-Community Development Director

**From:** Anna Jordan-Community Development and Housing Assistant

- **Housing:** Our department is currently working with two home owners for full rehabilitations. Specifications for one project came in under the program maximum. Project has been bid out to our contractors. We were working with another come home owner for full rehab, but the work specifications came in well above the allotted amount. An application was mailed to another individual that may benefit from this program as well. RRS items completed for one new home owner, and are in progress for a second. An approved home buyer is working with seller to get home qualified to utilized the home buyer assistance program. Another application was received, but home owner was over income guidelines. We have updated and continued contact with RPC regarding projects. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger. We look forward to assisting more residents with the available funding that we have received.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of October I received 23 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. We still are providing info to renters looking for housing. We are diverting calls to legal aid as necessary. These callers would include tenants that have already been evicted but believe so wrongfully. Increased calls have come in on landlords quitting on month to month contract tenants. Landlord and tenant complaint calls continue to stream in regarding negligent landlords. With these calls we continue to ask code enforcement for assistance, and give information to tenants in regards to escrowing rent.
- **Community Development:** Contracts for sub recipient funding have been fully executed. We are now able to start processing requisitions for sub recipients. Project is in works for a home buyer receiving new windows /doors. We are seeing a delay in receipt of material for job, but are excited to assist this home owner in the repair of her home. We currently have a roof replacement in progress, another just awarded to a contractor and a third that has been bid out. We are trying to get these completed prior to the winter weather. A home owner with original plumbing has been given application paperwork for assistance in getting her plumbing up to code.

- **Administrative:** Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed.

Attached is the report for the Massillon Fire Department for the month of October 2022.

The department responded to a total of 540 alarms during the month. This averages to 17.4 alarms per day. There were 182 fire alarm and public service calls, and 358 rescue and EMS calls. There were no injuries due to fire.

On the 4<sup>th</sup> of the month, we held our monthly Officers' meeting.

On the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended a virtual meeting with Bryx to discuss issues with the system. Representative from Jackson Township Fire Department and Red Center also attended the meeting. Bryx is an automated dispatch system that sets off station alert tones and broadcasts call information through automated voice. The system frees up dispatchers to remain on the phone with the caller and handle other necessary tasks related to the call while the system dispatches the proper units. The technical issues have been resolved and we are projected to start using the system in early November.

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the monthly L.O.G.I.C. Board meeting.

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of the month, we continued our hiring process and held second interviews. One candidate removed himself from the process prior to the interview. The remaining



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five candidates were interviewed by a five-member panel. All did well and remain on the eligibility list. Two were given and accepted conditional job offers and progressed through the remaining steps in the process with a projected start date in early November.

On the 11<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the bi-monthly Stark County IMAT meeting.

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of the month, Fire Prevention staff and I attended the Fire Prevention Breakfast recognizing Fire Prevention week. Inspector Tammy Wagner received the Dave DeMeo Award recognizing her excellent work over the past several years spearheading Fire Safety Education efforts in the City and neighboring areas.

On the 13<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the 911 Governance Board meeting.

On the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, and 21<sup>st</sup> of the month, we hosted a multi-jurisdiction training with Jackson Township Fire Department. The multi-jurisdictional trainings are valuable to our training program and we are seeing the benefits in increased interoperability with neighboring departments. A benefit that bolsters protection to residents in all communities.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended a Labor Management meeting with Director Sylvester and representatives of Local #251.

On the 27<sup>th</sup> of the month, Canton Township Fire Department hosted a multi-jurisdictional live fire training. I assisted by being one of the instructors and we had a crew of 3 participate in the training. The crew did an excellent job and represented the Massillon Fire Department well.

The total income tax receipts posted for October 2022 was \$2,047,688.64. This amount is an increase from October 2021 of \$499,088.56 (+32%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2022 was \$20,883,264.62. Receipts posted for 2022 was an increase from 2021 of \$1,875,092.21 (+10%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 71% of all tax collections through the year of 2022. Individual income tax payments represent 11% of all tax collections through the year of 2022 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 18%.

Average monthly income for the ten months of 2022 is \$2,088,326.46. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35.

Year to date refunds for 2022 was \$422,216.49 compared to refunds for 2021 of \$482,734.02. Refunds difference \$60,517.53 (more in refunds 2021 compared to 2022).

In October of 2022, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 63 traffic citations, 84 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 10 arrests for OVI, 2 more than were made in October of 2021. Radar Citations for the month totaled 2, this was 12 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 74 traffic accidents during October. That was 2 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 41 property damage accidents, 11 injury accidents, there were 21 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 12 hit skip accidents, and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 0 bicycle, 0 motorcycle, 1 pedestrian, and 6 commercial accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department also investigated 6 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 0 reported injuries. There were 0 fatal accidents. Of the above accidents 13 occurred during the night time.

In October of 2022 there were 61 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 6 less than were towed in October 2021. Of the above tows, 31 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 4 for traffic offenses of some type, 10 as a direct result of an arrest, and 13 for parking violations. There was 2 stolen/recovered vehicles and 1 miscellaneous tow.

During the month of October 2022 the traffic officer mailed 16 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 13 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During October 2022 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 7 motor vehicles. Also during the month of October, the traffic officer issued or acted upon 28 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices) issued 13 parking citations and investigated 0 school bus violations. The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners and conducted 0 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of October 2022 there were 55 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 55 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them and 3 are being held in secured storage.
