

Lincoln Way (State Route 172/241) Infrastructure Improvement Project Phase II

The project is improving infrastructure on State Route 172/241 (Lincoln Way) from 250' East of Tommy Henrich Blvd NW to 1st St SW and from 1st St NE to State Route 241 (Wales Rd NE). The project will join the previous phase of infrastructure improvements that was completed in 2020. The project is to include pedestrian curb bump outs, sidewalks, mast arm signalization, new street lighting, and new pavement. The project benefits include the safety of pedestrians by including curb bump outs, the improvement of the failing sidewalks and pavement, and upgrading the dated signalization and lighting of the area. In conjunction with phase I, water and gas lines were replaced throughout the project area. The area is in downtown Massillon and the heart of the City. Pedestrian traffic is high and encouraged as the central plaza and downtown shops are all within walking distance. The area also contains several outdoor cafes, outdoor amphitheater and walkways, spurring economic growth and stability.
