- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** This report has not change for our homeowner who has qualified for a Full Rehabilitation. We have received the Appraisal and notified the homeowner that we are ready to proceed on the first Rehab, however we did not receive a bid to proceed. We have begun the process of seeking a Contractor to do this Full Rehabilitation.
- We are in the beginning process with a homeowner, who needs of a Full Rehabilitation. We have just received the Application and additional paperwork.
- **Minor Repair:** Inspection for the homeowner, who needs of a rehab for his home, will not be able to get one because the amount exceeds the \$25,000. We are asking our Regional Inspector for the specifications to provide this homeowner with Minor Repair work, Minor Repair that may allow him assistance for plumbing, electric and gutters.
- Another homeowner was sent the packet for Minor Repair because of electrical issues, we have not received the paperwork back.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We provided a water heater for one homeowner, we have received the invoice and submitting for payment.
- We have another request for a water heater, we are waiting on verification paperwork to be returned so we can move forward in assisting.
- We have a request for plumbing assistance, we are waiting on paperwork.
- Roof needed for two home-owner, waiting on paperwork for one, and inspection sent for the other.
- A homeowner has requested windows, sent application waiting for his reply.
- **First time Homebuyer Assistance:** One of our first-time home-buyers Pre-construction meeting has been held and work is completed and Contractor paid. The first time homebuyer we reported on last month, received help from her parents and decided not to go through our program for down payment assistance.

- **Housing:** Our department currently has a homebuyer approved for our full rehabilitation program. Project has been bid out to contractors in hopes that better weather will allow completion of projects. A second income qualified home owner was income approved for program, but repairs will exceed budget maximum, this owner will be getting work done through our minor repair program. We have another application for full rehab, and we are working through getting an income approval. Application paperwork was sent to two potential home buyers. RRS items were completed for buyers who used out home buyer program this month. We have prepared set ups and completions as necessary for RPC regarding HOME projects. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger. Habitat requisition was received, and completion was sent to RPC .
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of March I received 18 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. Callers were looking for repair assistance, and had questions regarding eviction orders. Some were referred to courts with escrow questions. Code Services assisted renters with repair issues. Callers outside of Massillon were given contact information for someone who could assist them. Tenants have called with security deposit issues, some not receiving them back due to damages. -Fair housing board met again for a work session. We are hosting a fair housing luncheon in April with a guest speaker.
- **Community Development :** Emergency repair project for a roof was assigned to a contractor, we will be starting this project very soon. A bathroom modification has been bid out for a homeowner as well. A full rehab applicant that was not able to utilize the full rehab program will be receiving rehab assistance through CDBG funding as well. HMRP program ran during the month of March, we have begun working through the applications.
- **Administrative:** Manage phone calls. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Accurate and detailed notes taken for fair housing board meeting. Intake of HMRP applications.

Subject: Income Tax Monthly Report – March 2023

Date: April 6, 2023

The total income tax receipts posted for March 2023 was \$1,789,161.5. This amount is a decrease from March 2022 of \$400,171.46 (-18%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2023 was \$5,805,087.16. Receipts posted for 2023 was a decrease from 2022 of \$755,312.81 (-12%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 84% of all tax collections through the year of 2023. Individual income tax payments represent 12% of all tax collections through the year of 2023 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 4%.

Average monthly income for the three months of 2023 is \$1,935,029.05. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47.

Year to date refunds for 2023 was \$100,886.93 compared to refunds for 2022 of \$193,662.09. Refund difference \$92,775.16 (more refunds in 2022 compared to 2023).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 25.00% for the following accounts for 2023. Account percentages collected for the three months of 2023 are as follows:

In March of 2023 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 70 traffic citations, this is 26 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 9 arrests for OVI, 1 more than was made in March of 2022. Radar citations for the month totaled 4; this was 4 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 74 traffic accidents during March. This was 11 more than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 52 property damage accidents, 9 injury accidents and no fatal accidents. There were 13 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 7 hit skip accidents, and 3 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was no motorcycle, bicycle or pedestrian accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 4 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 0 injury. There was 9-night time and 1 commercial accident during the month.

In March of 2023 there were 53 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 26 less than were towed in March of 2022. Of the above tows, 38 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 0 for traffic offenses of some type, 7 as a direct result of an arrest and 8 for parking violations. There were 0 misc. tows and 0 recovered stolen vehicle.

During the month of March 2023 the traffic officer mailed 53 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 36 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During March 2023, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 20 motor vehicles. Also during the month of March, the traffic officer issued or acted upon 31 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 9 parking citation and investigated 5 school bus violations.

As of the last day of March 2023 there were 37 motor vehicles sitting in the impound lots of Patriot and Reed's Towing Services and 3 vehicles in secure storage. Of the 37 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.

Following is a breakdown of the individual tows, accidents, citations and OVI arrest for the month of March 2023.
