- **Fair Housing Calls for the Month: Beverly 29 Anna 25**

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** This report has not change for our homeowner who has qualified for a Full Rehabilitation. We have received the Appraisal and notified the homeowner that we are ready to proceed on the first Rehab, however we did not receive a bid to proceed. We have begun the process of seeking a Contractor to do this Full Rehabilitation.
- We are were working with a homeowner, who was in need of a Full Rehabilitation. Following the Regional Inspector report, this homeowner needs so much more in every area of her home. Therefore, we are unable to provide the full rehabilitation. We further tried to just get some minor repair work done, but the dis-repair is so bad until the Regional Inspector cannot provide specifications for any work to be done. Letter sent and cancelled assistance due to the fact that the work would exceed the amount for either.
- **Minor Repair:** We have asked and received the necessary revisions from the Regional Inspector to provide another homeowner with Minor Repair work, that may allow him repair for plumbing, electric and gutters. We have sent and received the intent to proceed from the homeowner and the work is out for bid.
- Another homeowner was sent the packet for Minor Repair because of electrical issues, we have not received the application or accompanying paperwork. Will call to see if they are still interested in assistance.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** A homeowner applied for help with a leaky pipe in her basement – at the time she had delinquent taxes. She corrected that issue and was sent an application packet on 4/28/2023, we have had not response at this time.
- We have another request for a roof, packet received and returned. We are working on the application and paperwork that accompanies to be able to ask for inspection and receive specification that will allow us to bid the work out.
- We have a request for plumbing assistance, we are waiting on paperwork, we will be calling to see if assistance is still needed.
- Roof needed for two home-owner, waiting on paperwork for one, and inspection sent for the other.
- A homeowner has requested windows, sent application waiting for his reply.
- **First time Homebuyer Assistance:** One of our first-time home-buyers Pre-construction meeting has been held and work is completed and Contractor paid. We have two First Time Homebuyers who have not returned paperwork to continue in our being able to provide down payment assistance. We will be calling to check on the status of them both.

- **Housing:** Housing department is working with an approved homeowner to make many needed repairs through our full rehab program. Applications have been sent to many hopeful buyers in the city of Massillon to use our home buyer's assistance program. We have prepared set ups and completions as necessary for RPC regarding HOME projects. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger. Habitat requisition was received, and completion was sent to RPC .
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of April I received 25 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. An ongoing issue between a landlord/tenant has been resolved through our resources. We answered many questions regarding eviction/service animals and renters rights this month. April is also fair housing month. Newspaper ads were placed promoting the fair housing department. We hosted a luncheon focusing on fair housing . There was a great turn out, and a great speaker that was able to educate many about issues and current fair housing regulations. – We did meet with the board several times to discuss the luncheons preparation.
- **Community Development :** We currently have a roofing project under way. We will soon sign documents to start a bathroom modification for a handicapped Massillon Home owner. Another application has been approved for assistance through the Minor repair program. HMRP applicants have been approved, and checks have been requested from the auditor's department. We had over 20 applications approved. We attended OCCD quarterly meeting this month. We always return with great networks and lots of informative information and legislative updates.
- **Administrative:** Manage phone calls. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Accurate and detailed notes taken for fair housing board meeting. Intake of HMRP applications.

The total income tax receipts posted for April 2023 was \$3,266,060.63. This amount is an increase from April 2022 of \$299,959.61 (+10%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2023 was \$9,071,147.79. Receipts posted for 2023 was a decrease from 2022 of \$455,353.20 (-5%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 72% of all tax collections through the year of 2023. Individual income tax payments represent 18% of all tax collections through the year of 2023 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 10%.

Average monthly income for the four months of 2023 is \$2,267,786.95. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47.

Year to date refunds for 2023 was \$183,979.20 compared to refunds for 2022 of \$234,317.34. Refund difference \$50,338.14 (more refunds in 2022 compared to 2023).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 33.33% for the following accounts for 2023. Account percentages collected for the four months of 2023 are as follows:

In April of 2023 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 101 traffic citations, this was 14 more than was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 10 arrests for OVI, 5 less than were made in April of 2022. Radar Citations for the month totaled 3; this was 1 less than during the same time period last year. Total charges for the month was 126.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 86 traffic accidents during April. This was 21 more than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 52 property damage accidents, 10 injury accidents, 0 fatal accident, and 23 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 14 hit skip accidents, and there were 0 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 0 pedestrian, 0 bicycle and 0 motorcycle accident during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 12 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 3 reported injuries. Of the above there was 7-night time and 3 commercial motor vehicle accidents.

In April of 2023 there were 56 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 13 less than were towed in April of 2022. Of the above tows, 25 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 14 as a direct result of an arrest, 11 for parking violations and 5 for traffic offenses of some type. There was 1 miscellaneous tow and 0 recovered stolen vehicle.

During the month of April 2023 the traffic officer mailed 15 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 9 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During April 2023, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 42 motor vehicles. Also during the month of April the traffic officer issued or acted upon 27 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 11 parking citations and investigated 1 school bus violations. There were no garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of April 2023 there were 43 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of the two city tow companies, Reed's and Patriot, with 4 vehicles in secure storage. Of the 53 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
