- Continued preparing for the FY2023 program year. The FY23 Annual Action Plan has now been approved by HUD. The next steps will be signing contracts with subrecipients and submitting legislation for appropriation. Also continued working on closeout of the 2022 program year.
- Continued working with Code Enforcement on the City's 2023 Demolition Program. The City has acquired a property on Main Avenue West that will be demolished.
- Continued accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures. Reported and made entries in IDIS for accounting management. Completed and updated accomplishments of CDBG activities in IDIS. Continued monitoring of CDBG sub recipients and their programs.
- Continued to monitor calls, responsibilities, and procedures of the CDBG Code Enforcement Contractor for the City. - Housing Rehabilitation Projects: Our Full Rehabilitation is completed and Contractor paid. We have another Full Rehabilitation, one bid received and another one promised, will have the Pre-Construction meeting and begin the work in August.
- Emergency Rehabilitation Projects/Minor Repair: We had the Pre-Construction meeting for our resident in need of assistance. The Minor Repair work has been completed and approved by regional inspector. Waiting on payment.
- We have another request for a roof, the work for this homeowner is completed, and waiting for the final inspection. Home owner in need of a roof has been sent paperwork. Another homeowner is in need of electrical assistance, we re-mailed. One disabled homeowner, in need of a ramp, has been ill and in a Nursing facility for rehabilitation. I spoke with her granddaughter who will be in town for a couple of weeks, who will assist her in getting the paperwork filled out so we can provide her with the ramp she needs.
- First time Homebuyer Assistance: We have three First Time Homebuyers, one of which has income approval, but is still in search of a home to purchase. The second applicant has turned in paperwork, but still has not found a home to purchase. We have a third applicant who has not been approved through a lender yet, but has been approved for assistance as a first time homebuyer.

- Webinars: July 25, Fair Housing Planning Monthly Office hours, I am learning how to Create a draft for fair housing plan 4-5p.m; July 26 and 27th, HUD Summer meeting 9 until- OCCD Business Meeting, held in Columbus, OH.
- Other Activities: Fair Housing – Fair Housing calls and activities include, referrals, information dissemination; planning and talking to Landlords concerning repairs and reasonable accommodation and tenant's rights in regards to their reasonable wear and tear, and their responsibilities as a tenant. Worked with Service Director and Economic Director to see if we could assist a homeless man. Diligently working with two young women, with several children, work through trying situations and trying to keep their housing. I continue to work with two men in the community who suffer from PTSD. I assist in fielding questions and concerns they have with their landlords.

MONTHLY REPORT: July 2023

- **Housing:** A full rehabilitation has been completed for a Massillon Homeowner, this project brought the home completely up to the code, made the home safer, and more sustainable as well . We are preparing to award a second full rehab to a contractor as well. We are excited to assist this homeowner to also bring their property up to code. She has leaking water, and other repair issues that are very much needed. We have two income approved buyers hoping to utilize our First-time home buyers' program. Both approved buyers are in the process of finding their homes. We continue to get calls regarding this program. Stark county RPC is continually updated on project status, set ups/completions and request for payment are submitted as necessary. The HOME financial ledger has been updated and maintained.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of July I received 19 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. We continue to receive calls for individuals looking for rental assistance, or lower income housing, although our programs can't assist with this need, we supply resources to callers best we can. We have had complaints of neglected repairs, and questions regarding escrowing rent. Calls are referred to code as necessary, information and phone numbers are supplied for individuals wanting to escrow rent. Date: August 2, 2023

The total income tax receipts posted for July 2023 was \$2,032,528.97. This amount is an increase from July 2022 of \$565,890.18 (+39%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2023 was \$15,258,681.27. Receipts posted for 2023 was an increase from 2022 of \$158,675.82 (+1%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 74% of all tax collections through the year of 2023. Individual income tax payments represent 14% of all tax collections through the year of 2023 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 12%.

Average monthly income for the seven months of 2023 is \$2,179,811.61. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47.

Year to date refunds for 2023 was \$368,311.91 compared to refunds for 2022 of \$359,999.26. Refund difference \$8,312.65 (more refunds in 2023 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 58.33% for the following accounts for 2023. Account percentages collected for the seven months of 2023 are as follows:

In July of 2023, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 124 traffic citations, 55 more traffic citations than was issued during the same time period last year. This resulted in a total of 161 traffic charges. The Massillon Police Department made 11 arrests for OVI, 5 more than was made in July of 2022. Radar Citations for the month totaled 34; this was 32 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 60 traffic accidents during July 2023. This was 2 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 38 property damage accidents, 13 injury accidents, and 8 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 15 hit skip accidents, and there was 1 accident that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 0 pedestrian, 2 bicycle, 1 motorcycle and 4 commercial accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 5 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 reported injury. There were 0 fatal accidents for the month of July 2023.

In July of 2023 there were 55 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was the same that was towed in July of 2022. Of the above tows, 22 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 3 for traffic offenses of some type, 18 as a direct result of an arrest, and 5 for parking violations. There were 7 vehicles towed as stolen/recovered or misc. tow.

During the month of July 2023 the traffic officer mailed 10 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 7 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During July 2023, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 12 motor vehicles. Also during the month of July, the traffic officer issued or took action on 16 warning notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court orders for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 12 parking citations and conducted 28 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of July 2023 there were 62 motor vehicles sitting at the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 62 vehicles, 2 are waiting for court orders to dispose of them as well as 3 being in secured storage.
