- **Fair Housing Calls for the Month: Beverly 19, Anna 24**

### **Code Enforcement Involvement - Yes as needed**

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** We have begun the verification for another Full Rehabilitation for a homeowner. Verifications are complete and Inspections are underway. The report for inspection found that the Rehabilitation would be in excess of \$30,000. Our limit is \$25,000 so we will have to walk away from this one.
- **Minor Repair:** We were able to Re-schedule the Pre-Construction meeting and repair is underway. Another resident has had the pre-construction meeting and the electrical work on her home has begun.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We have paperwork for a resident who needs a roof, we are working with him and his family because of compromised conditions he cannot be in the home when the roof is being replaced. He will have to leave the home and serious cleaning will have to be done before he can return.
- **First time Homebuyer Assistance:** We have also closed on two more first time homebuyers, one has had the pre-construction meeting for RRS and work has begun. The First Time Homebuyer who missed the Pre-construction meeting is still under review. We have another first-time home buyer's near to closing. We are waiting for the Closing Disclosure and a date for closing. We are working with another first-time homebuyer who has been approved and has a purchase agreement. We have requested the Regional Inspector to inspect for worthy purchase.

## MONTHLY REPORT: June 2022

**To:** Samantha Walters-Community Development Director

**From:** Anna Jordan-Community Development and Housing Assistant

- **Housing:** We continue our search for a house that qualifies for the Full Rehab program, a pending application had a work specification that far exceeded guidelines. As a department we discussed this ongoing issue, and will meet with County to discuss options. A contractor has begun completion of RRS items for a recent buyer that used our Down payment assistance program. We currently have one approved applicant for our home buyer program, buyer is scheduled to close within next weeks. A second buyer has been income approved. A purchase order was accepted, and work specifications have been requested on pending property. We continue to receive calls regarding down payment assistance program. We have updated and continued contact with RPC regarding projects. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of June I received 24 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. A lot of calls continue to come in for residents looking for rental property, we supply resources/contacts when we receive these calls. Many tenants called complaining about lack of repairs. Code enforcement assists with repair calls. We also provide information to tenants on steps to take to escrow rent if necessary. Fair housing work session was held. It was later determined that it is in best interest of department to postpone the fair housing luncheon for the 22' program year. Our quarterly meeting will be held in July.
- **Community Development:** On site monitoring of sub recipients is well under way for the 21' program year. We have begun preparations for the new program year. Sub recipients were updated on available block grant funds they still had available.  
A minor repair project has been completed. Homeowner was without electricity in half of her home for over a year, it has been repaired and updated. # TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In June of 2022, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 73 traffic citations, 71 less than was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 11 arrests for OVI, 5 less than were made in June of 2021. Radar citations for the month totaled 5; this was 16 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 73 traffic accidents during June. This was 14 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 43 property damage accidents, 8 injury accidents, there were 21 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 14 hit skip accidents, and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. The Massillon Police Department investigated 8 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 reported injuries. There was 1 motorcycle, 0 bicycle, 0 pedestrian, and 4 commercial accidents during the month. There were 0 fatal accident in the city in the month of June.

In June of 2022 there were 50 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 34 less than the number towed in June of 2021. Of the above tows, 23 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 5 for traffic offenses of some type, 14 as a direct result of an arrest, 5 for parking violations. There was 1 recovered stolen vehicle and 1 misc. tows.

During the month of June 2022, the traffic officer mailed 25 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 18 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During June 2022 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 18 motor vehicles. Also during the month of June the traffic officer issued or acted upon 23 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 6 parking citations and investigated 0 school bus violation.

As of the last day of June 2022 there were 44 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of the two towing companies, Reed's and Patriot, with 3 in secured storage. Of the 44 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
