Monthly Report: August, 2023

- Attended the following meetings/events:
 - August 2 – Meeting with CommQuest Family Living Center staff
 - August 2 – OCCD Organizational Meeting
 - August 2 – A Taste of Massillon committee meeting
 - August 16 – Social Services Summit at Massillon Salvation Army
 - August 23 – Webinar: Preparing a Successful Bid for State Capital Budget
- Participated in the 2023 Fun Fest. The housing department had a booth set up with outreach information and a family-friendly housing activity. The purpose of attending is to educate the Community on Fair Housing regulations and programs that the housing department operates.
- Began preparing the City Property Sale program that was passed by City Council in July. We began accepting bids for vacant city-owned parcels this month.
- Continued preparing for the FY2023 program year. The FY23 Annual Action Plan has now been approved by HUD. The next steps will be signing contracts with subrecipients and submitting legislation for appropriation. Also continued working on closeout of the 2022 program year.
- Continued working with Code Enforcement on the City's 2023 Demolition Program. The City has acquired a property on Main Avenue West that will be demolished. Additional dilapidated structures have been identified and demolition activities will begin once appropriation legislation is passed by City Council.
- Continued accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures. Reported and made entries in IDIS for accounting management. Completed and updated accomplishments of CDBG activities in IDIS. Continued monitoring of CDBG subrecipients and their programs.
- Continued to monitor calls, responsibilities, and procedures of the CDBG Code Enforcement Contractor for the City. Reviewed and monitored all record keeping being sure requirements are being followed to HUD Guidelines. Ensured Code compliance monitoring was being performed by the Contractor in the City Target Areas.



- During the month of August, I responded to a total of 7 Public Record requests for records from various City departments. The majority of these requests were for police videos and reports.

- **Fair Housing Calls for the Month: Beverly 26 Anna 21**

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** We have begun a Full Rehabilitation for a homeowner – it is in progress.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects/Minor Repair:** We have a request for a roof for one homeowner scheduled to begin in September. We have two requests for roofs, one has income approval and work specification have been requested. The other one is approved and waiting for specifications to proceed. We have a request for electric upgrade, work specification needed from building dept. We have received another request for a roof, application mailed 8/31/23. Another household has requested a roof and gutters, our application packet has been sent, the only thing returned is the receipts for the lead booklet.
- One homeowner has been ill and in a Nursing facility. We still have not heard back from her or family members in regards to assistance for a ramp.
- **First time Homebuyer Assistance:** We have two First Time Homebuyers, one of which has income approval, but is still in search of a home to purchase. The second applicant has turned in paperwork, but still has not found a home to purchase. One applicant requesting assistance had ownership of a mobile home, which eliminated her from qualifying as a first-time home-buyer.

- **MEETINGS ATTENDED DURING THE MONTH WERE:** August 1, 2023 – Fair Housing set up and attend National Night Out and distributed flyers and information August 8, 2023 – COC Board Meeting 9:30-11:00 - attended our Staff Meeting in Mayor's conference room; August 12, 2023 – Fun Fest from 10-2 in Duncan Plaza and surrounding area. Gave our flyers, activities to the kids. Great day; August 14, viewed a 45 minute training from BPI, informing how re recognize scams and e-mail that can capture one system. Social Service Summit – Salvation Army- Anna attended 9-10; August 23, 10:30 pre-construction meeting for Full Rehabilitation; 9-10 Regional Planning CDBG Virtual Meeting. August 29, overview of fair housing planning & process 4-5 (had trouble getting on).
- **Webinars:** August 29, Fair Housing Planning Monthly Office hours, Creating a draft for fair housing plan 4-5p.m;
- **Other Activities: Fair Housing –** Fair Housing calls and activities include, referrals, information dissemination; planning and talking to Landlords concerning repairs and reasonable accommodation and tenant's rights in regards to their reasonable wear and tear, and their responsibilities as a tenant.

MONTHLY REPORT: August 2023

- **Housing:** Currently the housing department has a full rehabilitation in progress. The homeowner is using the program to update house to code, including a new roof. We have two income approved buyers hoping to utilize our First-time home buyers' program. We are staying in contact with them during their buying process. The housing market is small within their budgets, so having trouble finding a home to purchase. All program brochures have been updated with new year numbers. Stark county RPC is continually updated on project status, set ups/completions and request for payment are submitted as necessary. The HOME financial ledger has been updated and maintained.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of August I received 21 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. We continue to receive calls for individuals looking for rental assistance, or lower income housing, although our programs can't assist with this need, we supply resources to callers best we can. We have had complaints of neglected repairs, and questions regarding escrowing rent. Calls are referred to code as necessary, information and phone numbers are supplied for individuals wanting to escrow rent. A lot of questions have come in regarding an apartment complex with new management. We have handled calls as they come in, and helped tenants navigate this process. We had two community out reach events this month, National night out and the Massillon funfest. Both are great opportunities to get information about the Fair housing department.
- **Community Development :** Our new program year is under way, and we have 3 pending roof/gutter jobs for homeowners experiencing leaks in their roofs. Another homeowner called and is income approved for new wiring /electric in home. The wiring is very old, and in need of update per City code ordinance. Calls continue to come in for Emergency and minor repair programs. Currently we are waiting on two other applications to be returned. Sub-recipient contracts have been sent and are being returned. The department responded to a total of 537 alarms during the month. This averages to 17.3 alarms per day. There were 175 fire alarms and/or public service calls, and 362 rescue and EMS calls. There was one minor civilian injury this month due to fires.

On the 3rd of the month, I attended the LOGIC Board meeting.

Asst. Chief Spicocchi and the uniform committee completed their work and have submitted recommended changes to the uniform policy. The recommendations are under review and a final approved draft should be ready by the end of September.

Asst. Chief Rhodes and Captain Castile are preparing final recommendations for a trailer to carry our rope rescue and technical rescue equipment.

The total income tax receipts posted for August 2023 was \$1,595,285.48. This amount is a decrease from August 2022 of \$257,080.87 (-14%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2023 was \$16,853,966.75. Receipts posted for 2023 was a decrease from 2022 of \$98,405.05 (-1%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 75% of all tax collections through the year of 2023. Individual income tax payments represent 13% of all tax collections through the year of 2023 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 12%.

Average monthly income for the eight months of 2023 is \$2,106,745.84. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47.

Year to date refunds for 2023 was \$415,323.21 compared to refunds for 2022 of \$372,014.01. Refund difference \$43,309.20 (more refunds in 2023 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 66.67% for the following accounts for 2023. Account percentages collected for the eight months of 2023 are as follows:

In August of 2023, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 112 traffic citations, 46 more traffic citations that was issued during the same time period last year. This resulted in a total of 150 traffic charges. The Massillon Police Department made 14 arrests for OVI, 3 more than was made in August of 2022. Radar Citations for the month totaled 16; this was 13 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 66 traffic accidents during August 2023. This was 3 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 34 property damage accidents, 8 injury accidents, and 24 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 12 hit skip accidents, and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was no pedestrian or bicycle, but 1 motorcycle accident. There were 5 commercial accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 7 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 reported injuries. There were 0 fatal accidents.

In August of 2023 there were 74 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 17 more than were towed in August of 2022. Of the above tows, 24 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 7 for traffic offenses of some type, 26 as a direct result of an arrest, and 16 for parking violations. There were 0 vehicles towed as stolen/recovered and 1 misc. tow.

During the month of August 2023 the traffic officer mailed 29 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 19 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During August 2023, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 9 motor vehicles. Also during the month of August, the traffic officer issued or took action on 32 warning notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court orders for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 19 parking citations and conducted 2 garbage truck inspections and investigated 0 school bus violation

As of the last day of August 2023 there were 51 motor vehicles sitting at the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 51 vehicles, several are waiting for court orders to dispose of them as well as 3 being in secured storage.
