COUNCILMAN LEWIS – So this is a \$5,000.00 appropriation for the Stark Economic or \$4,000, I'm sorry, for the Stark Economic Development Board?

<u>TED HERNCANE</u> - \$3,333.33 would be for the City's annual contribution to their 3-year fund drive. I did increase it a couple of hundred dollars to cover any cost we may have this year because we also pay recording and title and some other fees related to the Vacant Lot Utilization Program and some other things that may come from the Land Bank. So, I asked for a little bit of a cushion to cover some of those costs between now and the end of the year, should we have any.

<u>COUNCILMAN LEWIS</u> – Because those are...so when we have the fees that you are discussing, those are things that we register with this Stark County Board and then we have to pay them?

TED HERNCANE – Correct.

COUNCILMAN LEWIS – And then the \$3,300.00 or whatever, that's an annual contribution we make for?

<u>TED HERNCANE</u> – So back in 2012 and the late Councilwoman Halter was a huge proponent of this when we did it the first time, the City never contributed to the Stark Economic Development Board annual fund drive. They do it on a 3-year basis, so, what we have done since is make a 3-year commitment of \$10,000.00 where it's obviously broken down into thirds, so, every year we provide that as the City's support for the services and assistances they offer us throughout the year.

COUNCILMAN LEWIS – Thank you. I just needed a refresher.

TED HERNCANE – Anytime.

COUNCILMAN LEWIS – I have no further questions.

TED HERNCANE – Thank you.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT SLATER – Thank you.
