- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** We have begun a Full Rehabilitation for a homeowner – it is in progress. Much of the work has been accomplished, however some of the materials have been back ordered and they are waiting to complete some of the work. We allow 90 days for a full rehabilitation to be completed, they have plenty of time. First payment made to contractor, received reimbursement from RPC.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects/Minor Repair:** We have a request for a roof completed. Contractor is scheduled to be paid. We have four requests for roof. Three were sent the ‘the intent to proceed’ one was returned and we are waiting of two to be returned. Request for electric work was received, ‘intent to proceed’ was sent at the end of September. Request for a hot water heater and another for a furnace. Nothing returned on either of these two requests.
- One homeowner has been ill and in a Nursing facility. We still have not heard back from her or family members in regards to assistance for a ramp. We have had no response of this one to date.

- **Housing:** Currently the housing department has a full rehabilitation in progress. The homeowner is using the program to update house to code, including a new roof. Our Home buyers' program is currently on HOLD. We will re-evaluate the situation after the first of the year. Stark county RPC is continually updated on project status, set ups/completions and request for payment are submitted as necessary. The HOME financial ledger has been updated and maintained. New program funding is being updated and activities set up as needed.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of September I received 27 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. We had a lot of calls this month regarding tenant/landlord issues. Some issues were referred out as is a civil issue., and in many cases, we worked with tenant and landlord/management to resolve the situation in manner that was best for everyone. Several callers had complaints of neglected repairs, and questions regarding escrowing rent. Calls are referred to code as necessary, information and phone numbers are supplied for individuals wanting to escrow rent. We have handled calls as they come in, and helped tenants navigate this process.
- **Community Development :** Our new program year is under way. A roof was just completed for a homeowner. We have 2 more roof projects bid, as well as moving forward with electrical update in a house. We are working with a long-time resident to get her furnace repaired as well. All home owners are utilizing the emergency/minor repair program. . Sub-recipient contracts have been sent and are being returned. Once fully executed , sub-recipients can complete requisitions. CDBG ledgers are being updating and new activities are being set up in IDIS. We continue to aid with resources for homeowners outside of city limits, as well as give information for people over income.
- **Administrative:** Manage phone calls. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Prepare documents as needed for meetings.

On the 29th of the month, Fire Inspector Pat Eddy was sworn in as an Auxiliary Police Officer with the Massillon Police Department after completing OPOTA training. This will enable the Fire Prevention Bureau to investigate fires, especially arson fires, more effectively and efficiently. This will also alleviate some of the burden on the police department's detective bureau by reducing the needed interaction with arson cases allowing them to maintain their focus on other important cases they are investigating.

Personnel completed a total of 83.5 hours of fire training in September. This included ladder operations, large flow nozzle deployment, and rope rescue systems. Members also completed 138 hours of EMS continuing education training in September. Several members completed their required advanced cardiac life support (ACLS) refresher training.

The required annual ladder testing was completed in September. All ground ladders and both the ladder truck and the aerial tower truck passed inspection and testing.

Pump testing will be completed in October with SCBA (self-contained breathing apparatus) bench testing following soon after. This will complete our required annual equipment tests.

The total income tax receipts posted for September 2023 was \$1,889,986.62. This amount is an increase from September 2022 of \$6,782.44 (0%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2023 was \$18,743,953.37. Receipts posted for 2023 was a decrease from 2022 of \$91,622.21 (0%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 75% of all tax collections through the year of 2023. Individual income tax payments represent 12% of all tax collections through the year of 2023 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 13%.

Average monthly income for the nine months of 2023 is \$2,082,661.49. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47.

Year to date refunds for 2023 was \$426,355.26 compared to refunds for 2022 of \$422,216.49. Refund difference \$4,138.77 (more refunds in 2023 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 75% for the following accounts for 2023. Account percentages collected for the nine months of 2023 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In September of 2023, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 107 traffic citations, 37 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. There was a total of 133 charges. The Massillon Police Department made 6 arrests for OVI, 5 less than was made in September of 2022. Radar Citations for the month totaled 8, this was 2 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 80 traffic accidents during September. That was 14 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 42 property damage accidents, 9 injury accidents, there were 28 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 9 hit skip accidents, and there were 0 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 0 bicycle and 0 pedestrian accidents during the month. There was 1 motorcycle accident during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 4 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 reported injury. There was 0 commercial and 0 fatal accidents.

In September of 2023 there were 59 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 2 less than were towed in September 2022. Of the above tows, 26 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 8 for traffic offenses of some type, 9 as a direct result of an arrest, and 14 for parking violations. There were 2 stolen/recovered vehicles and 0 miscellaneous tow.

During the month of September 2023 the traffic officer mailed 30 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 26 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During September 2023 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 4 motor vehicles. Also during the month of September, the traffic officer issued or acted upon 22 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices) issued 19 parking citations and investigated 0 school bus violations. The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners and conducted 0 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of September 2023 there were 56 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 56 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them and 0 are being held in secured storage.
