- Housing Rehabilitation Projects: We have two Full Rehabilitation. We have received the Appraisal and notifying the homeowner that we are ready to proceed. We have received the specifications for the second Full Rehabilitation. However, the roof for this one will have to be done before the full rehabilitation. We have requested bids from our Contractors to be able to move forward. Once we repair the roof, we will be able to move forward with getting the appraisal for the home.
- Minor Repair: We have a roof that will be done for one of our home owners who is disabled.
- Emergency Rehabilitation Projects: We have paperwork for a resident who needs a roof, we are working with him and his family because of health compromised conditions he cannot be in the home when the roof is being replaced. He recently had another major surgery. We will have to start paperwork over to move forward. We have a resident who is requesting windows and doors, we have had the pre-construction meeting and as soon as the Contractor can get the doors and windows the work can begin.

With these calls we continue to ask code enforcement for assistance, and give information to tenants in regards to escrowing rent.

Contracts for sub recipients have been mailed out. We currently have a long-time resident of Massillon received assistance for new windows and doors on her home, this will help her home be safe and more efficient. Bids are out for another home owner needing emergency roof repair. Sewer line repair for a Massillon resident have been completed as well using CDBG funding.

Attached is the monthly report for the Massillon Fire Department for September 2022.

The department responded to a total of 532 alarms during the month. This averages to 17.7 alarms per day. There were 167 fire alarm and public service calls and 365 rescue and EMS calls. There were no fire-related injury or casualty for the month.

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of the month, we held a monthly officer meeting after suspending the meetings during the summer months.

On the 7<sup>th</sup> of the month, we held a civil service entrance exam for firefighter/paramedic. A morning session and an evening session were held where a total of 15 candidates sat for the test. All 15 passed the exam and were placed on an eligibility list. Six candidates on the list currently do not meet all criteria to move forward in the process. As they complete their training and obtain the necessary certifications, they will become eligible for future steps in the process if we need to hire again prior to the list's expiration.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the monthly L.O.G.I.C. Board meeting.

On the 13<sup>th</sup> of the month, Captain Ganoe attended the Staff Meeting held at the Legends.

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Mental Health Transportation Committee meeting held virtually. The committee has been able to implement a couple of the ideas discussed in previous meetings providing the different agencies (fire/EMS, law enforcement, and Crisis) responding to these types of incidents some guidance on transportation options.

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, Asst. Chief Spicocchi and I attended the County Fire Chiefs meeting. The transfer of MARCS (Multi-Agency Radio Communication System) radio fees from the County to the individual agencies was discussed. When the County moved to the MARCS system in 2018, part of the agreement with the State (administrators of the system) was the county received a credit based on a percentage of the cost to upgrade existing radio towers and the construction of additional towers. The county elected to use the credit to cover system radio maintenance fees for four years. The four-year period ends in December of this year and in January 2023, we become responsible for the fees.

On the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of the month, we conducted new hire 1<sup>st</sup> interviews. We had 9 candidates eligible to sit for the interview. Six candidates will move forward to 2<sup>nd</sup> interviews in early October.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Disabilities Commission Meeting.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month, I met with our EMS billing agency and representatives from the billing software company to discuss compatibility issues between the billing software and ESO incident reporting software we transitioned to on September 1<sup>st</sup>. Those issues have been resolved.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month, I along with Jackson Twp. Fire Department representatives and the Director of RED Center met virtually with the Bryx project manager to discuss issues with the Bryx system installed at RED Center. The Bryx system provides automated alert tone activation and automated voice dispatching of incidents to RED Center Fire/EMS agencies allowing dispatchers to perform their jobs more efficiently. Solutions are being worked out and the system should be operational by mid to late October.

Required yearly physicals for members began in September and will be completed in early October. Part of the physical, is the completion of the EA Wellness health check form which should help the City obtain another reduction in health insurance premiums in 2023.

We went live with ESO incident reporting on September 1<sup>st</sup>. The transition has gone relatively smoothly and as we expected. Members' learning curves are flattening, and the issues or glitches have been or are close to being resolved.

We are obtaining proposals to update the Fire Station Location Analysis completed in 2014 as a component of the Ohio Fire Chiefs Study. The update is needed due to changes in city development,

especially on the west side, and a significant increase in call volume that has occurred since the 2014 analysis. The total income tax receipts posted for September 2022 was \$1,883,204.18. This amount is an increase from September 2021 of \$135,768.37 (+8%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2022 was \$18,835,575.98. Receipts posted for 2022 was an increase from 2021 of \$1,376,003.65 (+8%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 69% of all tax collections through the year of 2022. Individual income tax payments represent 12% of all tax collections through the year of 2022 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 19%.

Average monthly income for the nine months of 2022 is \$2,092.841.77. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35.

Year to date refunds for 2022 was \$403,256.31 compared to refunds for 2021 of \$436,839.93. Refunds difference \$33,583.62 (more in refunds 2021 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 75.00% for the following accounts for 2022. Account percentages collected for the nine months of 2022 are as follows:

In September of 2022, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 70 traffic citations, 54 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 11 arrests for OVI, 2 less than was made in September of 2021. Radar Citations for the month totaled 10, this was 3 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 66 traffic accidents during September. That was 6 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 32 property damage accidents, 12 injury accidents, there were 21 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 9 hit skip accidents, and there were 5 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 1 bicycle and 2 pedestrian accidents during the month. There were no motorcycle accident during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 8 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 reported injuries. There was 1 fatal accident.

In September of 2022 there were 61 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 33 less than were towed in September 2021. Of the above tows, 27 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 10 for traffic offenses of some type, 12 as a direct result of an arrest, and 9 for parking violations. There were 0 stolen/recovered vehicles and 3 miscellaneous tow.

During the month of September 2022 the traffic officer mailed 28 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 21 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During September 2022 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 13 motor vehicles. Also during the month of September, the traffic officer issued or acted upon 26 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices) issued 11 parking citations and investigated 1 school bus violations. The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners and conducted 0 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of September 2022 there were 52 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 52 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them and 1 are being held in secured storage.
