A new home buyer using the down payment assistance program closed on their home this month. We just received an application for another potential buyer. Information on this project is provided almost daily. We have prepared set up and completions as necessary for RPC regarding projects. The project waiting list has been continually updated, as well as the housing financial ledger.
- Fair Housing: For the month of December I received 14 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. We are providing information for legal aid as necessary. Information on calls is collected when received, this helps maintain record for return calls and assists in forwarding information to other departments as necessary. Details of several calls were forwarded to code enforcement. Departments work together to make sure rentals are registered, and landlords are maintaining properties per City ordinance codes. Callers are also provided information on the steps to put rent into escrow accounts. We have received calls from people looking for rental assistance. We provide any information and resources available to assist.

We were also able to assist a home owner who lost electric due to lines being ripped from home following an accident. Application paperwork was sent to a homeowner requiring a new hot water tank. We are already preparing for the 2023 sub recipient workshop, and will begin taking applications later this month. Ads have been set up for newspaper. The attendance and interest of the virtual workshop has been excellent, and we plan to continue to get information to the organizations that could benefit from CDBG funding.

Date: January 8, 2023

The total income tax receipts posted for December 2022 was \$1,790,750.89. This amount is a decrease from December 2021 of \$15,983.40 (-1%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2022 was \$24,149,048.98. Receipts posted for 2022 was an increase from 2021 of \$1,055,627.33 (+5%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 73% of all tax collections through the year of 2022. Individual income tax payments represent 10% of all tax collections through the year of 2022 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 17%.

Average monthly income for the twelve months of 2022 is \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35.

Year to date refunds for 2022 was \$528,793.72 compared to refunds for 2021 of \$505,722.49. Refunds difference \$23,071.23 (more refunds in 2022 compared to 2021).

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In December of 2022 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 97 traffic citations, 7 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 10 arrests for OVI, this was the same as in December of 2021. Radar citations for the month totaled 2; this was 7 less than were issued last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 89 traffic accidents during December. This was 6 more than last year at this time. There were 66 property damage accidents, 12 injury accidents, and 10 that occurred on private property. There was 0 fatal accident during the month. Of the above accidents, there were 9 hit skip accidents and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no motorcycle or bicycle accidents and no pedestrian accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 8 accidents involving juveniles during the month of December resulting in 3 injuries and 7 commercial accidents.

In December 2022 there were 74 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 1 more then as was towed in December of 2021. Of the above tows, 44 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 7 for traffic offenses of some type, 17 as a direct result of an arrest, 2 for parking violations and 4 miscellaneous tows. There were 0 recovered stolen vehicles during the month. The traffic officer issued 2 parking citation in the month of December.

During the month of December 2022 the traffic officer mailed 54 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer processed 42 title searches with the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During December 2022, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 27 motor vehicles. Also during the month of December the traffic officer issued or acted upon 36 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of December 2022 there were 47 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 47 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them. 3 vehicles are being held in secure storage.
