- Continued closeout of the 2019 Program Year, which ended June 30, 2020. This included auditing
 sub recipient files, gathering data for input in to IDIS, and preparing for the upcoming CAPER.

 the Contractor in the City Target Areas. Monitored to be sure the Standard Operating Procedures for
 CDBG Code Enforcement are being followed.

Date: September 4, 2020

The total income tax receipts posted for August 2020 was \$1,547,321.42. This amount is an increase from August 2019 of \$176,860.84 (+13%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the eight months of 2020 was \$13,949,417.39. Receipts posted for 2020 was a decrease from 2019 of \$-334,163.46 (-2%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 72% of all tax collections through the year of 2019. Individual income tax payments represent 16% of all tax collections through the year of 2019 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 12%.

Average monthly income for the eight months of 2020 is \$1,743,677.17. Average monthly income for the year of 2019 was \$1,758,409.86. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69.

Year to date refunds for 2020 was \$245,727.58 compared to refunds for 2019 of \$218,178.26. Refunds difference \$27,549.32 (more in refunds 2020 compared to 2019).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 66.67% for the following accounts for 2020. Account percentages collected for the eight months of 2020 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

MONTH OF AUGUST 2020

In August of 2020, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 115 traffic citations, 26 Less traffic citations that was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 4 arrests for OVI, 13 less than was made in August of 2019. Radar Citations for the month totaled 26; this was 2 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 63 traffic accidents during August 2020. This was 29 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 42 property damage accidents, 8 injury accidents, and 13 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were11 hit skip accidents, and there was 1 accident that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no pedestrian or bicycle, 1 motorcycle accident during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 3 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 reported injuries. There were 0 fatal accidents.

In August of 2020 there were 67 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 34 less than were towed in August of 2019. Of the above tows, 21 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 3 for traffic offenses of some type, 9 as a direct result of an arrest, and 32 for parking violations. There was 1 vehicles towed as stolen/recovered and 0 misc. tow.

During the month of August 2020 the traffic officer mailed 30 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 20 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During August 2020, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 15 motor vehicles. Also during the month of August, the traffic officer issued or took action on 56 warning notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court orders for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 24 parking citations and conducted 9 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of August 2020 there were 64 motor vehicles sitting at the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 64 vehicles, several are waiting for court orders to dispose of them as well as 2 being in secured storage.
