Attached is the monthly report for the Massillon Fire Department for December, 2018.


The department responded to a total of 499 alarms during the month. This averages to 16.1 alarms per day. There were 85 fire alarm and public service calls, and 414 rescue and EMS calls. There was 1 civilian fatality; 5 civilian injuries and 2 firefighter injuries due to fire. Once again, this year represents the busiest year in the history of the Massillon Fire Department in that it answered 6,048 calls for assistance from the public.

On the 6th of the month, I attended the monthly LOGIC Board meeting.

There were a string of fires toward the end of the year resulting in 1 fatality and several injuries to civilians and firefighters. It is important to emphasize fire prevention and education to our resident families. Their lives may depend on it.

The migration to Stark MARC'S radio platform continues on track as is Station # 3 renovation.

The total income tax receipts posted for December 2018 was \$1,928,484.51. This amount is an increase from December 2017 of \$14,477.60 (+1%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2018 was \$20,890,844.36. Receipts posted for 2018 was an increase from 2017 of \$+71,538.34 (+0.34%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 75% of all tax collections through the year of 2018. Individual income tax payments represent 14% of all tax collections through the year of 2018 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 11%.

Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2018 was \$508,819.65 compared to refunds for 2017 of \$436,697.53. Refunds difference \$72,122.12 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2017).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 100% for the following accounts for 2018. Account percentages collected for the twelve months of 2018 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In December of 2018 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 167 traffic citations, 26 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 12 arrests for OVI, this was 5 more than were made in December of 2017. Radar citations for the month totaled 21; this was 10 more than were issued last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 86 traffic accidents during December. This was 30 less than last year at this time. There were 49 property damage accidents, 11 injury accidents, and 26 that occurred on private property. There were no fatal accidents during the month. Of the above accidents, there were 13 hit skip accidents and there were 3 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no motorcycle or bicycle accidents and 2 pedestrian accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 6 accidents involving juveniles during the month of December resulting in 2 injuries.

In December 2018 there were 71 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 2 less than were towed in December of 2017. Of the above tows, 35 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 7 for traffic offenses of some type, 13 as a direct result of an arrest, 14 for parking violations and no misc. tows. There were 2 recovered stolen vehicles during the month. The traffic officer issued 15 parking citations and conducted 1 school bus violation investigation.

During the month of December 2018 the traffic officer mailed 32 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer filed 20 title searches with the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During December 2018, the traffic officer was able to junk, or title, 15 motor vehicles. Also during the month of December the traffic officer issued, or acted upon, 30 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of December 2018 there were 89 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 89 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
