- Assisted Code Enforcement with coordination demolition of unsafe structure located at 878 Walnut Road SE. This property is mixed commercial and residential use. Demolition contract was awarded and an asbestos survey was obtained during the month of December. Abatement and demolition activity to begin in January.
- Continued preparing for our FY 2021 CDBG Sub Recipient Workshop, which will be held on January 6, 2021. This year's workshop will look much different than the past as we will be using UberConference and teaching virtually. Discussion at this workshop will include:
 - o Program overview and application process
 - o HUD National Objectives and expenditure requirements
 - Eligible activities
 - o Reporting, requisitioning, and monitoring expectations

- Housing Rehabilitation Projects: We received the Regional Inspectors for a finished rehabilitation. We have submitted for the Lead Inspection to close this one out.
 We have two Full Rehabilitations in beginning stages. We will be looking forward to beginning the work on them both in January, 2021.
- Minor Repair: Covid-19 Assistance This one is underway. They have received a new roof and windows were
 ordered but delayed in coming in over the holidays. Hopefully they will be installed in January.
- Emergency Rehabilitation Projects: Work has begun on one of the roofs, the other one will be ready for bid, the first week in January. Work will begin as soon as we get a contractor and a good bid.
- <u>First time Homebuyer Assisted:</u> We have three First Time Homebuyers. We are still gathering verifications for one perspective homebuyer. The second one is still looking for a lender to support his purchase and the other one is working with us, SMHA and their financial institution to purchase their first home.
- (We have had two of our first time homebuyers request for release. They have paid back the money through transactions with their Title Company and we have sent copies of the Satisfactions to the Title Companies.

 They sent us their respective check, which we received as program income and returned to the HOME program. Lynn Carlone has instructed how this is to be done.)

The total income tax receipts posted for December 2020 was \$1,518,889.69. This amount is a decrease from December 2019 of \$-404,384.77 (-21%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the twelve months of 2020 was \$20,089,576.15. Receipts posted for 2020 was a decrease from 2019 of \$-1,001,342.15 (-5%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 74% of all tax collections through the year of 2020. Individual income tax payments represent 14% of all tax collections through the year of 2020 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 12%.

Average monthly income for the twelve months of 2020 is \$1,674,131.35. Average monthly income for the year of 2019 was \$1,758,409.86. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69.

Year to date refunds for 2020 was \$358,154.09 compared to refunds for 2019 of \$367,132.26. Refunds difference \$8,977.27 (more in refunds 2019 compared to 2020).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 100.00% for the following accounts for 2020. Account percentages collected for the twelve months of 2020 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In December of 2020 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 108 traffic citations, 2 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 6 arrests for OVI, this was 2 less than were made in December of 2019. Radar citations for the month totaled 11; this was 5 more than were issued last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 70 traffic accidents during December. This was 23 less than last year at this time. There were 48 property damage accidents, 13 injury accidents, and 9 that occurred on private property. There was 1 fatal accident during the month. Of the above accidents, there were 13 hit skip accidents and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no motorcycle or bicycle accidents and no pedestrian accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 2 accidents involving juveniles during the month of December resulting in no injuries.

In December 2020 there were 73 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 6 more than were towed in December of 2019. Of the above tows, 40 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 9 for traffic offenses of some type, 11 as a direct result of an arrest, 12 for parking violations and 2 miscellaneous tows. There were 3 recovered stolen vehicles during the month. The traffic officer issued 5 parking citation in December.

During the month of December 2020 the traffic officer mailed 28 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer processed 22 title searches with the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During December 2020, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 32 motor vehicles. Also during the month of December the traffic officer issued or acted upon 26 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of December 2020 there were 46 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 46 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them. 3 vehicles are being held in secure storage.

Following is a breakdown of the individual tows, accidents, citations and OVI arrests for the month of December 2020.
