Subject: Income Tax Monthly Report – December 2021

Date: January 5, 2022

The total income tax receipts posted for December 2021 was \$1,806,734.29 This amount is an increase from December 2020 of \$287,846.60. (+19%)

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2021 was \$23,093,441.65. Receipts posted for 2021 was an increase from 2020 of \$3,003,865.50. (+15%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represent 70% of all tax collections through the year of 2021. Individual income tax payments represent 12% of all tax collections through the year of 2021 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 18%.

Average monthly income for the twelve months of 2021 is \$1,924,453.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35. Average monthly income for the year of 2019 was \$1,758,409.86.

Year to date refunds for 2021 was \$505,722.49 compared to refunds for 2020 of \$358,154.99. Refunds difference \$147,567.50 (more refunds in 2021 compared to 2020).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 100.00% for the following accounts for 2021. Account percentages collected for the twelve months of 2021 are as follows:

On the 16th of the month, I attended the L.O.G.I.C. Board meeting.

On the 17th of the month, Asst. Chief Harbaugh, Capt. Ganoe, and I met with John Picard to review initial drawings for potential Station 1 renovation.

On the 20th of the month, I attended a L.O.G.I.C. Board grievance hearing.

On the 27th of the month, I attended a County Fire Chiefs meeting via Zoom to discuss extended hospital delays for EMS crews transferring care to Emergency Department staff and possible changes in medical control for 2022.

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In December of 2021 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 104 traffic citations, 4 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 10 arrests for OVI, this was 4 more than were made in December of 2020. Radar citations for the month totaled 9; this was 2 less than were issued last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 83 traffic accidents during December. This was 13 more than last year at this time. There were 51 property damage accidents, 8 injury accidents, and 14 that occurred on private property. There was 0 fatal accident during the month. Of the above accidents, there were 10 hit skip accidents and there were 4 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no motorcycle or bicycle accidents and no pedestrian accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 2 accidents involving juveniles during the month of December resulting in no injuries and 1 commercial accident.

In December 2021 there were 73 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was the same as was towed in December of 2020. Of the above tows, 38 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 5 for traffic offenses of some type, 16 as a direct result of an arrest, 14 for parking violations and 0 miscellaneous tows. There were 0 recovered stolen vehicles during the month. The traffic officer issued 14 parking citation in December.

During the month of December 2021 the traffic officer mailed 59 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer processed 41 title searches with the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During December 2021, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 18 motor vehicles. Also during the month of December the traffic officer issued or acted upon 16 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of December 2021 there were 64 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 64 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them. 3 vehicles are being held in secure storage.
