Attached is the monthly report for the Massillon Fire Department for February, 2019. The department responded to a total of 501 alarms during the month. This averages to 17.9 alarms per day. There were 106 fire alarm and public service calls, and 395 rescue and EMS calls. There were no injuries due to fire this month.

On the 5th of the month, the Fire Department (along with several other resource agencies) responded to the area of 1888 Southway SE for a 6" natural gas line rupture. This incident was the first to test the StarkMARC'S radio system and all agencies were able to communicate seamlessly.

On the 7th of the month, I attended the monthly LOGIC Board meeting. Ladder 1 (1998 Quint) was permanently removed from service as the frame is cracked and corroded. The cost of repairs exceed \$400,000 and it is unsafe to dirve or operate. Steps will be taken to secure a grant for a new apparatus of this type.

On the 21st of the month, Fire Prevention attended the college career night at Washington High School to provide career information on becoming a firefighter/paramedic.

Affinity Hospital is a prime resource to acquire supplies, materials and furnishings not only for Station # 3 and its renovation project but also for the other stations. We will not spend tax dollars on items that can be repurposed from the hospital.

The total income tax receipts posted for February 2019 was \$1,544,544.65. This amount is an increase from February 2018 of \$+128,972.85 (+9%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2019 was \$3,308,343.44. Receipts posted for 2019 was an increase from 2018 of \$+34,146.37 (+1%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 83% of all tax collections through the year of 2019. Individual income tax payments represent 13% of all tax collections through the year of 2019 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 4%.

Average monthly income for the two months of 2019 is \$1,654,171.72. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2019 was \$30,515.45 compared to refunds for 2018 of \$17,549.22. Refunds difference \$\$12,966.23 (more in refunds 2019 compared to 2018).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 16.67% for the following accounts for 2019. Account percentages collected for the two months of 2019 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In February 2019 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 155 traffic citations, 38 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 5 arrests for OVI, which was 10 less than were made in February of 2018. Radar Citations for the month totaled 18, this was 8 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 55 traffic accidents during February. This was 18 less than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 45 property damage accidents and 11 injury accidents. There were no fatal accidents and 21 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 13 hit skip accidents, and 1 accident that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no pedestrian involved accidents or motorcycle accidents. There were no bicycle accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 3 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 injuries.

In February 2019 there were 55 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 4 less than were towed in February of 2018. Of the above tows, 28 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 15 as a direct result of an arrest, 8 for parking violations and 4 for traffic offenses of some type. There were no recovered stolen vehicles and no misc. tows.

During the month of February 2019 the traffic officer mailed 37 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 26 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During February 2019 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 33 motor vehicles. Also during the month of February the traffic officer issued or acted upon 27 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 6 parking citations and investigated no school bus violations.

As of the last day of February 2019 there were 46 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 46 vehicles several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
