- **Fair Housing Calls for the Month:** Beverly 20 - Samantha 17 call Total 37 for July

Were any of them discrimination related? No

Major Concerns? Received a call from tenants who moved to a space that was said to be completed but when it rained the basement was completely drenched with water. They were originally told that the wetness they saw in the basement was wet cement. However upon inspection, the basement was wet mud.

Another disabled tenant needed bars put in his bathroom and railing for his steps, we worked with the landlord to get this done. Progress is on-going.

Code Enforcement Involvement? We worked with Code to inspect and provide the owner with repair instructions for the first tenant concern. Tenants were granted their request to move out because full disclosure was not made upon agreement. The manager will not be able to rent this house until repairs are made and inspected by Code.

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** We have two nearing completion and a new full rehabilitation out to bid.
- **Minor Repair** - One Minor Repair near completion
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We completed electrical work for one homeowner. We are ready to provide a roof for another homeowner.
- **FIRST TIME HOMEBUYERS ASSISTED:** We have assisted one First Time homebuyer and have bids out to Contractors for bids to be submitted to complete the work bringing everything up to minimum code standards.

- **Housing:** Currently working on one Full Rehabilitation project and one Minor Repair project (installation of a water heater for a low income elderly resident).
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of June I received 17 Fair Housing inquiries in addition to those that Bev received. The majority of these calls were tenant concerns and complaints. Several of the calls taken were referred to Code Enforcement for review. One of these calls was successfully resolved by persuading a landlord to install new sidewalk around the building where a wheelchair bound citizen resides. Another call came from a disabled citizen that had received a 30 day notice to vacate his apartment; The Fair Housing Department was able to assist with conflict resolution between the tenant and landlord, and the notice to vacate was revoked.
- **NIP:** Submitted 9 reimbursement packets for demolished properties. Bids were awarded for asbestos abatement and property demolition on an additional 17 properties.
- **Meetings:** For the month of June I participated in the following meetings:

16th Street SE Storm Sewer Repair – Review options for 2019 project.

Springhill Settlement Drainage – Review options for underdrains & storm sewer rehab. Develop plans & specs. Survey done. Expecting Fall bid Phase I.

Castle West Drainage - Review options for underdrains & storm sewer rehab. Develop plans & specs. Survey done.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT

WWTP Upgrade Project – Current project scope is to upgrade the existing WWTP average daily flow from 15.8 MGD to 17.0 MGD; modify existing aeration tanks, primary and secondary clarifiers, and sludge pumping to enable biological nutrient removal; replace and upgrade tertiary filter capacity; modify sludge conditioning and digestion facilities; modify and upgrade electrical and instrumentation systems. Construction began in March of 2016.

STREETS

Wales Road (SR 241) Improvement Project – Funding has been secured through SCATS for FY 2022. Project will improve the existing roadway and infrastructure from Lincoln Way (SR172) to Hills & Dales. OHM developing schedule, scope and costs, survey. ODOT LPA let project.

Springhill Settlement Reconstruction – Developing estimate and survey. Exploring funding options, evaluating drainage.

Richville Dr. Widening - Awarded by OPWC July 2018. Bid opening July 11, 2018. Northstar low bidder. Awaiting AT&T pole relocation. Dominion gas PIR project relocation, Aqua hydrant relocations.

2018 Street Resurfacing Project – Began estimating and evaluating streets for 2018. Street list was compiled, and project bids opened on March 28, 2018. Northstar Asphalt is lowest bidder. Paving complete on Thomas Circle, Colonial Parkway, 23rd NE, Milburn, Kaylynn, Virginia SE. Moved to West side to replace ramps and catch basins.

2018 Target Area Streets – Bid opening June 21st. Northstar Asphalt low bidder. Work to begin in September.

SIGNALS

Various Intersections – Evaluations of additional intersections being performed. Cameras installed at various intersections to evaluate traffic. 16/16 videos completed. Analysis of 5 additional intersections by OHM, not warranted. Begin process of removing traffic control, next two intersections.

Lincoln Way W/Lillian Gish/Tommy Henrich – Analysis of dedicated left turn arrows for traffic flow. Waiting for equipment to be installed by Safety Department.

SUBDIVISIONS

Augusta Lakes Phase 3 – Plans submitted and under review by City Engineer.

Country View Meadows - Need to install street lighting and complete punch list items.

Buckeye Ridge Estates – Preliminary plat submitted to Planning Commission May 13, 2015. Resubmitted a revised preliminary plat to Planning Commission June 29, 2015. Final plat approved by Planning Commission August 26, 2015 and Council September 21, 2015.

Sippo Reserves Allotment Phase II – Project has been transferred to a new developer, who will be completing any remaining items.

Westbrook Estates Phase IV – Preliminary plat approved by Planning Commission May 13, 2015. Construction plans approved. Final plat approved by Planning Commission on January 13, 2016 and Council on February 16, 2016. Construction of pipe and structures is nearly complete. Roadway installed Fall 2017. Working on underground utilities, street lighting, and housing construction.

Westbrook Estates Phase V - Plans submitted and under review by City Engineer.

Kenyon Creek Phase 2 and 3 – Plans submitted and under review by City Engineer.

On the 25th of the month, I attended the quarterly LEPC meeting.



The total income tax receipts posted for July 2018 was \$1,519,409.17. This amount is a decrease from July 2017 of \$-19,336.83 (-1%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the seven months of 2018 was \$13,114,434.71. Receipts posted year to date through the seven months was an increase from 2017 of \$+123,828.28 (+1%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 72% of all tax collections through the year of 2018. Individual income tax payments represent 18% of all tax collections through the year of 2018 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 10%.

Average monthly income for the seven months of 2018 is \$1,873,490.68. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2018 was \$437,921.65 compared to refunds for 2017 of \$333,954.41. Refunds difference \$103,967.24 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2017).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 58.33% for the following accounts for 2018. Account percentages collected for the seven months of 2018 are as follows:



In July of 2018, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 202 traffic citations, 37 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 9 arrests for OVI, 8 less than were made in July of 2017. Radar Citations for the month totaled 38; this was 21 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 99 traffic accidents during July 2018. That was 19 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 41 property damage accidents, 26 injury accidents, and 32 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 6 hit skip accidents, and there were 5 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no pedestrian, bicycle or motorcycle accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 12 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 reported injuries. There was 1 fatal accident.

In July of 2018 there were 69 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 2 less than were towed in July of 2017. Of the above tows, 42 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 7 for traffic offenses of some type, 7 as a direct result of an arrest, and 12 for parking violations. There was 1 vehicle towed as stolen/ recovered and there were no misc. tows.

During the month of July 2018 the traffic officer mailed 28 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 23 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During July 2018, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 30 motor vehicles. Also during the month of July, the traffic officer issued or acted upon 24 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 15 parking citations and conducted 42 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of July 2018 there were 65 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 65 vehicles several, are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
