Homeowner was contacted with the great news. A lot of calls regarding assistance programs. New program year began July 1, we are waiting for funding.
- Fair Housing: For the month of June I received 20+ fair housing calls. Callers included both tenants and landlords. With a more expanded understanding of fair housing regulations and help of department director, I have become more confident in handling these calls accurately. A lot of issues were resolved with communication and help of fair housing. We discussed plans for the Fair housing booth at the fair housing meeting this month. I also took notes at this meeting to prepare and update minutes and agenda.
- <u>Community Development:</u> Began preparing IDIS for new fiscal year programs. Still waiting on deposit of funding. Attended OCCD conference in Columbus for first time this was both a great networking and very educational experience.
- NIP: Beginning to prepare packets for NIP reimbursements. Prepared contracts on current NIP projects, clean out and asbestos abatement under way for current projects. Also, prepared several items for board of control. We are working vigorously on these items, as the NIP program concludes.
- Administrative: Prepared and paid bills/did IDIS drawdowns for funds. With assistance
 of department director, ledgers have been updated and are accurate going into the new
 fiscal year. Ordered and have been able to execute documents with my notary stamp.

Subject: Income Tax Monthly Report –July 2019

Date: August 6, 2019

The total income tax receipts posted for July 2019 was \$1,394,843.31. This amount is a decrease from July 2018 of \$-124,565.86 (-8%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the seven months of 2019 was \$12,912,120.27. Receipts posted for 2019 was a decrease from 2018 of \$-201,314.44 (-2 %).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 88% of all tax collections through the year of 2019. Individual income tax payments represent 10% of all tax collections through the year of 2019 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 2%.

Average monthly income for the seven months of 2019 is \$1,844,731.47. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69. Average monthly income for the year 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2019 was \$176,406.27 compared to refunds for 2018 of \$437,921.65. Refunds difference \$261,515.38 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2019).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 58.33% for the following accounts for 2019. Account percentages collected for the seven months of 2019 are as follows:

TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In July of 2019, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 111 traffic citations, 91 less traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 11 arrests for OVI, 2 more than were made in July of 2018. Radar Citations for the month totaled 17; this was 21 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 83 traffic accidents during July 2019. That was 16 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 42 property damage accidents, 15 injury accidents, and 26 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 9 hit skip accidents, and there were 6 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no pedestrian, bicycle or motorcycle accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 2 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 reported injury. There were 2 fatal accidents.

In July of 2019 there were 63 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 6 less than were towed in July of 2018. Of the above tows, 29 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 12 for traffic offenses of some type, 12 as a direct result of an arrest, and 8 for parking violations. There were no vehicles towed as stolen/recovered and there was 1 misc. tow.

During the month of July 2019 the traffic officer mailed 41 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 26 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During July 2019, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 18 motor vehicles. Also during the month of July, the traffic officer issued or took action on 59 warning notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court orders for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 9 parking citations and conducted 24 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of July 2019 there were 37 motor vehicles sitting at the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 37 vehicles, several are waiting for court orders to dispose of them.
