- Submitted the PR-29 Financial Accounting Report to HUD for calendar year 2021 Quarter 2, which covers April 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021.
- Submitted legislation to City Council amending the CDBG-CV portion of the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan. The City received notice from HUD that we were receiving a third and final round of CDBG-CV funds that must be used to prepare for, prevent, or respond to the Coronavirus pandemic.
- Continued preparing the second substantial amendment for the 2020 Annual Action Plan to include the above-mentioned funding and modified activities.
- Continued preparing the 2021 HOME contracts for planned projects.
- Continued working with Code Enforcement on the City's 2021 Demolition Program. Coordinated asbestos surveys, asbestos abatement, demolition bids, etc. on Round 1 of demolitions.
- Continued accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures. Reported and made entries in IDIS for accounting management. Completed and updated accomplishments of CDBG activities in IDIS. Continued monitoring of CDBG sub recipients and their programs.

- **Fair Housing Calls for the Month: Beverly 20 Anna 18**

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** Presently, we have two Full Rehabilitations on the move.
- **Minor Repair:** We have bids out again for a ramp and lift.
- We also have another requesting plumbing and electric. Bids have been received and awarded. Scheduled to begin this month.
- We have received the request for a home owners windows and electric work to be done. We have the specifications for the electrical work that needs to be done inside her home. After talking with Frank Silla, we will be requesting a contractor that will reconnect the outside power to the house.
- Application sent out to a lady who is requesting help with her front and back porch, We have the specifications for this one, and have bid it out. We do not have any bids yet.
- We have received a bid for a homeowner in need of electrical work. This one will begin this month.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We have bids out for another roof.
- We also have another couple who has yet to complete verification.
- We have finally contacted the homeowner in need of a furnace. She has been ill, and lost the papers we originally sent; we have re-sent the forms to her. Presently, we have not heard back from her.
- We have another homeowner in need of a furnace, we are waiting on her paperwork for verification. We have not heard back from her.
- **First time Homebuyer Assisted:** The work is complete for one of our First time Homebuyer, and she has been closed out.
- We have provided another first-time homebuyer with down payment assistance, complete of June 30, 2021. We have sent out the Intent to proceed for RRS items completion.
- We have also closed on two more first time homebuyers and sent them the Intent to Proceed so that we can do their RRS items.
- We have a home buyer completing the Homebuyer course nearing closing.
- There are two other homebuyers, still early in the process and in varying positions.

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- **OTHER ACTIVITIES: FAIR HOUSING** – We had several fair housing calls during the month. Many of which dealt with possible evictions and repairs. We offer suggestions to the tenants on how to deal with their situations. They do not necessarily want their landlords contacted, but want to know what they can do to get repairs. We also dealt with tenants whose landlords were selling or not renewing lease agreements or allowing month to month to continue. We found out that the moratorium is extended to October 3, 2021, which will give tenants some additional time to find another place to rent if eviction or the landlord decides to sell of the property is presented.

## **Monthly Report: July 2021**

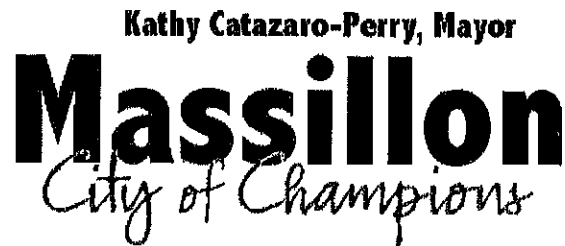

- **Housing:** Working with two home owners for Full Rehabs: Appraiser has been asked to assess the first property, so we can get bid out to contractors. Work specification has been requested for second property. Homebuyers: We had two home owners close on houses this month. One that moved from out of state into Massillon. These homeowners will all be getting repairs using the RRS portion for this program. We have two more approved, and two more applications were just received this week. This program continues to bring new residents to our city.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of July I received 18 fair housing calls. Calls included both landlord, tenant and repair issues. We have continued to educate ourselves on protection and assets available to tenants facing foreclosure. We have seen that many landlords are giving 30-day notices on month to month renters in order to sell properties due to booming housing market at this time. Fair housing plans to attend the funfest in August, and have begun preparing for that as well.
- **Community Development:** A completed roof for a homeowner this month. We also did some repairs on a roof for a homeowner that had leaking. We have another approved home owner through emergency program for a bad roof. We have approved applicants for a roof job and a repairs furnace., Two minor repair projects are in process. Electric and plumbing being repairs for these home owners. Bid requests sent for new windows for a home owner.
- **Administrative:** Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Housing project ledger is up to date. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed.

The total income tax receipts posted for July 2021 was \$1,473,312.77. This amount is a decrease from July 2020 of \$526,025.26. (-26%)

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2021 was \$13,984,912.50. Receipts posted for 2021 was an increase from 2020 of \$1,657,483.22. (+13%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represent 69% of all tax collections through the year of 2021. Individual income tax payments represent 15% of all tax collections through the year of 2021 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 16%.

Average monthly income for the seven months of 2021 is \$1,997,844.64. Average monthly income for the year of 2020 was \$1,674,131.35. Average monthly income for the year of 2019 was \$1,758,409.86.

Year to date refunds for 2021 was \$374,042.40 compared to refunds for 2020 of \$223,451.92. Refunds difference \$150,590.48 (more refunds in 2021 compared to 2020).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 58.33% for the following accounts for 2021. Account percentages collected for the seven months of 2021 are as follows:

# TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

## MONTH OF JULY 2021

In July of 2021, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 100 traffic citations, 12 less traffic citations that was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 6 arrests for OVI, 3 less than was made in July of 2020. Radar Citations for the month totaled 21; this was 10 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 51 traffic accidents during July 2021. This was 18 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 31 property damage accidents, 6 injury accidents, and 14 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 10 hit skip accidents, and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There were no pedestrian, 1 bicycle, motorcycle accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 5 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 3 reported injury. There were 0 fatal accidents.

In July of 2021 there were 53 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 7 less than were towed in July of 2020. Of the above tows, 19 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 5 for traffic offenses of some type, 16 as a direct result of an arrest, and 11 for parking violations. There were 2 vehicles towed as stolen/recovered or misc. tow.

During the month of July 2021 the traffic officer mailed 26 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 18 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During July 2021, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 32 motor vehicles. Also during the month of July, the traffic officer issued or took action on 26 warning notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court orders for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 8 parking citations and conducted 33 garbage truck inspections.

As of the last day of July 2021 there were 48 motor vehicles sitting at the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 48 vehicles, several are waiting for court orders to dispose of them as well as 3 being in secured storage.
