## **MONTHLY REPORT: July 2025**

From: Anna Jordan-Community Development Coordinator

- **Housing:** Full rehab project is underway per contractor. We will provide information regarding the program, and send application packets to anyone that meets the requirements. As needed we are providing information to persons that call looking for housing assistance, including down payment assistance, homeless assistance, and low-income housing. We are prepping for the summer outreach opportunities, including Massillon Funfest, where we provide an activity to kids, and information to parents .
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of July received 18 calls . We received calls regarding repairs, lease agreements, and service animal questions. We assess calls and determine if a fair housing complaint is needed. We work as a middle person for landlord/tenant issues as needed. Some were given information regarding legal aid. We continue to receive calls from people looking for subsidized or low-income housing, as well as homeless individuals looking for housing. We supply as many resources as possible.
- **Community Development :** A code referred roofing project is 95% complete. The contractor is making the needed corrections. We have two partially received applications, one for roof assistance, and one for plumbing related issues. We have a homeowner income approved that needs gutters/window work. We have an intent to proceed out to homeowners that applied for roof assistance. We will assist homeowners that are eligible as long as funding is available. Sub-recipient program year ended June 30<sup>th</sup>. We have almost received all requisition requests from the organizations. We have begun working on the CAPER for this program year.
- **Administrative:** Manage phone calls. IDIS activities and projects set up, funded, and updated as necessary. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Ledgers balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Prepare documents as needed for meetings. Application packets prepared and mailed. New files set up as needed.

### **Economic Development**

Fielded calls regarding new business opportunities to discuss site location, zoning, and site plan review procedures. Met with Aqua Ohio representatives on current and future development projects. Attended quarterly Stark Economic Development Board (SEDB) board meeting. Attended NEFCO (Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning & Development Organization) monthly board meeting. Director of Development was appointed by the Stark County Commissioners to serve on this board. Worked with Law Department and Engineering Department on parcel transfer to CIC for Massillon Energy & Technology Park. Met with Chad and Michelle Hartman to discuss their redevelopment project at 47 LWW. City will provide CRA tax exemption as local investment as required for Ohio Historic Preservation Tax Credits. Met with proposed new tenant at Rite Aid building downtown, discussed zoning issues.

### **Community Development**

Continued CDBG administrative duties including accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures, monitoring expenditures for all activities in IDIS, and monitoring of CDBG sub recipients and their programs. Fielded calls from residents regarding the City's vacant land reutilization program and questions regarding zoning requirements for various projects. Worked with code enforcement officers and held weekly status meetings to go over procedures, record keeping, and implementation of the International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC). For CDBG FY 2025 City of Massillon will receive \$646,321 which is a 0.992% decrease from the grant amount estimated at the time of passage by City Council. Began work on FY 2024 CAPER due on September 30. Started environmental and historic preservation reviews for four (4) CDBG demolition projects.

Activity overview for July 2025:

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of the month, Fire Prevention inspectors spent the day with the July 3<sup>rd</sup> Fireworks detail. The fireworks display went off without any issues.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of the month, Fire Inspector Tammy Wagner retired after 27 plus years of service. Inspector Wagner spent the last 7 to 8 years of her career in the Fire Prevention Bureau where she made great strides improving the public safety education program especially in the local schools. From the 14<sup>th</sup> to the 17<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Ohio Fire Chiefs Association Conference. Primary topics included recruitment and retention, firefighter mental well-being, and legislative bills regarding funding through property taxes.

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> of the month, I attended the RED Center budget meeting. A proposed budget was finalized and will be presented at the August L.O.G.I.C. Board meeting.

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> of the month, I attended Java with Jones event at Stark State College with several area fire and EMS service leaders. Discussion included what Stark State's Emergency Service programs can offer regional fire and EMS departments, how to improve the programs to meet today's environment, and the possibility of bringing back some advanced training aimed at students with experience in fire and EMS. The discussion was very productive and I believe we will see positive changes in the programs benefiting our members and service.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Stark County Fire Chiefs Association meeting hosted by North Lawrence Fire Department.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month, Asst. Chief Spicocchi attended the County Collaborative Training Committee meeting. Projects include continuing Mayday training prep and delivery and developing a common command board used by incident commanders.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the County Hazmat Executive Board meeting.

Also, on the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the County TROT (technical rescue) Executive Board meeting.

Also, on the 29<sup>th</sup> of the month, JTFD Chief Tim Berczik, JTPD Chief Mark Brink, and I met with Ohio Senator Jane Timken to discuss issues facing public safety in the region.

Personnel completed facility walkthroughs of the new elementary schools familiarizing themselves with layouts and protection systems in place. Our instructors spent the month discussing and planning training events using 2 potential buildings on the St. Mary's Church property. Using acquired structures creates a more realistic training environment while training on a number of different tasks and procedures. Members also completed EMS continuing education hosted by Cleveland Clinic Mercy.

The Fire Prevention Bureau continued working with school administration and contractors completing required inspections on the new elementary schools. The schools should be on track to open as scheduled in early September. The inspectors continued preparing for a busy early

The total income tax receipts posted for July 2025 was \$2,090,873.38. This amount is an increase from June 2024 of +0.31%.

Year to date income tax receipts posted through July 2025 was \$16,216,616.02. Receipts posted for 2025 is an increase from 2024 of +1.24%.

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 74% of all tax collections through the year of 2025. Individual income tax payments represent 13% of all tax collections through the year of 2025 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 13%.

Average monthly income for the seven months of 2025 is \$2,316,659.43. Average monthly income for the year of 2024 was \$2,129,262.05. Average monthly income for the year of 2023 was \$2,060,967.62.

Year to date refunds for 2025 was \$451,740.06.

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 58.33% for the following accounts for 2025. Account percentages collected for the seven months of 2025 are as follows:
