Attached is the monthly report for the Massillon Fire Department for June, 2021.

The department responded to a total of 472 alarms during the month. This averages to 15.7 alarms per day. There were 149 fire alarms and public service calls, and 323 rescue and EMS calls. There were 0 firefighter or civilian injuries due to fires.

On the 1st of the month, I attended a Microsoft Teams meeting with the Devin Moore Heart Foundation regarding a partnership to conduct CPR/AED awareness training at an event held in the City.

On the 2nd of the month, seven captains went through the assessment center for Assistant Chief conducted by the Ohio Fire Chiefs Association.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of the month, EMS Coordinator Markwood and I met with officials from Aultman Massillon to discuss operations and minor issues.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of the month, Katelyn Lindsay, Matthew Seward and Bryan McMaster completed their probationary period. They have proven to be valuable assets to the department.

On the  $9^{\text{th}}$  of the month, I attended the monthly LOGIC meeting.

On the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, the truck committee and I went to Sutphen for a preconstruction meeting regarding the new quint.

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Crisis Protocol meeting on Microsoft Teams to discuss handling mental health issues.

On the 18<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended our second negotiation meeting with Local 251 members. Both sides are to be commended for their efforts to complete the process in a timely and professional manner.

On the 21st of the month, Captain Vince Spicocchi was sworn in as Assistant Chief. We expect many good things from Asst. Chief Spicocchi in his new position.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of the month, EMS Coordinator Markwood and I met with Aultman Canton officials to discuss operations and minor issues.

On the 29th of the month, I attended the monthly Hazmat Exec Board Meeting.

On the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month, Firefighter/Medic Brian Weber was sworn in as a Captain/Medic. Brian brings a calm demeanor and strong leadership to the position.

The annual Cruise-On-In-and-Dance show was cancelled due to Covid-19 health orders still in effect at decision time.

The City adopted the final COVID-19 Incident Action Plan on June 4<sup>th</sup> leaving the end date and time open. Subsequently, the Governor ended most health orders and removed the State of Emergency status for Ohio. On the 18<sup>th</sup> of the month, the City's Administration and Incident Commanders decided it was time to remove the City's State of Emergency. COVID-19 is still a factor, however, the actions and precautions put in place over the past year have significantly reduced COVID-19's impact. City employees and residents are to be commended for their dedication and patience over the last year.

- Submitted legislation to City Council amending the award amount for PY21. The City received notice in May that HUD's Office of Community Planning and Development has discovered an error in the formula calculations for the CDBG program. The correction of this error has resulted in the City of Massillon receiving an increase of 1.47%, which equals \$9,704.
- Continued planning and setting up projects, activities, and preparing agreements for the 2021
   Program year for both HOME and CDBG, which begins on July 1, 2021. Completed environmental reviews for the PY21 activities.
- Began preparing the 2<sup>nd</sup> substantial amendment for the 2020 Annual Action Plan. This amendment allows us to allocate the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final round of CDBG-CV funding that has been awarded to Massillon.
- Continued working with Code Enforcement on the City's 2021 Demolition Program. Coordinated cleanout and asbestos survey work on Round 1 of demolitions.
- Continued accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures. Reported and made entries in IDIS for accounting management. Completed and updated accomplishments of CDBG activities in IDIS. Continued monitoring of CDBG sub recipients and their programs.
- Continued to monitor calls, responsibilities, and procedures of the CDBG Code Enforcement
  Contractor for the City. Reviewed and monitored all record keeping being sure requirements are
  being followed to HUD Guidelines. Ensured Code compliance monitoring was being performed by
  the Contractor in the City Target Areas..
- During the month of June, I responded to a total of 22 Public Record requests for records from various City departments. The majority of these requests were for police incident/accident reports.

- Housing Rehabilitation Projects: We have another Full Rehabilitation on the move, we have received the specifications and sending to the appraiser for the appraisal.
- We are also in the beginning stages of another Full Rehabilitation.
- Minor Repair: We do have a couple of requests for Minor Repairs. We have the Ramp and lift sent to Contractors for bids, we have not received a bid for this one yet, however we will bid it out again.
- We also have another requesting plumbing and electric. Bids have been received and awarded.
- We have received the request for a home owners windows we have received the specifications, but she needs of an electrician to re-attach the power company's electric connector to her home that a branch dislodged; her daughter also thinks that there may need to be some electrical work inside. After talking with Frank Silla, we will be requesting a contractor that will reconnect the outside power to the house. Frank will do an assessment of the inside needs for electrical work that may be needed.
- Application sent out to a lady who is requesting help with her front and back porch, we do not have the specifications for this one yet.
- We have received a bid for a homeowner in need of electrical work. We are ready to set up the pre-construction meeting.
- Emergency Rehabilitation Projects: We have bids out for another roof.
- We also have another couple who has yet to complete verification.
- We have finally contacted the homeowner in need of a furnace. She has been ill, and lost the papers we originally sent; we have re-sent the forms to her.
- We have another homeowner in need of a furnace, we are waiting on her paperwork for verification.
- First time Homebuyer Assisted: The work is complete for one of our First time Homebuyer, and she has been closed out.
- We have provided another first-time homebuyer with down payment assistance, complete of June 30, 2021.
   We will be sending out her paperwork for RRS items completion.
- We have another one pending closing.
- We had a first-time homebuyer back out of receiving our assistance due to the fact that their lender did not like
  the terms of our program. They would not allow the homebuyer to receive our down payment assistance
  because they said their investors would not work with them because we place a lien of the property for five
  years. This sounds like a broker situation and our lien would not allow them to sell the mortgage.
- We have a home buyer completing the Homebuyer course nearing closing.
- There are two other homebuyers, still early in the process and in varying positions.

We offer suggestions to the tenants on how to deal with their situations. They do not necessarily want their landlords contacted, but want to know what they can do to get repairs. We also dealt with tenants whose landlords were selling or not renewing lease agreements or allowing month to month to continue. We found out that the moratorium was extended to July 31, 2021, which will give tenants some additional time to find another place to rent if eviction or sell of the property is around the corner.

- 1. Housing: Full Rehab: Work specifications received, came in within guidelines, will get intent to proceed sent. A second full rehab is awaiting work specification. Homebuyers: We had two homeowners close on their new homes in Massillon this month, we will get started on RRS item repair soon. We have two more approved, and nearing closing. One approved buyer had to proceed without our program, as the lender would not accept our assistance. We continue to take applications and received interest in program.
- Fair Housing: For the month of June I received 13 fair housing calls. Calls included both landlord, tenant and repair issues. We have started getting calls with vacate or eviction questions. Renters have reached out concerning rent increases as well. We have seen that many landlords are giving 30-day notices on month to month renters in order to sell properties due to booming housing market at this time.
- Community Development: One emergency roof job was assigned to a contractor, and preconstruction meeting was held. An intent to proceed was sent to another home owner for an emergency roof, and we received work specifications for a third roof project. We have an application for a new furnace through emergency program as well. Work specifications received for new windows for a home owner also. An electric job was assigned to a contractor for a minor repair, homeowner received a new furnace, now we are updating her unsafe electric. We also bid out a minor repair for electric/plumbing repair job. We have began preparing for the 2021 FY.
- Administrative: Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary.
   Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Housing project ledger is up to date. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed.

# TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

# **MONTH OF JUNE 2021**

**DATE:** July 5, 2021

In June of 2021, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 144 traffic citations, 44 more than was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 16 arrests for OVI, 10 more than were made in June of 2020. Radar citations for the month totaled 21; this was 3 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 87 traffic accidents during June. This was 17 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 49 property damage accidents, 11 injury accidents, there were 27 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 22 hit skip accidents, and there were 1 accident that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. The Massillon Police Department investigated 5 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 2 reported injuries. There was 1 motorcycle, 0 bicycle, 0 pedestrian, and 1 commercial accident during the month. There were 0 fatal accident in the city in the month of June.

In June of 2021 there were 84 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 11 more than the number towed in June of 2020. Of the above tows, 39 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 4 for traffic offenses of some type, 27 as a direct result of an arrest, 13 for parking violations. There was 0 recovered stolen vehicle and 1 misc. tows.

During the month of June 2021, the traffic officer mailed 35 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 23 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During June 2021 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 24 motor vehicles. Also during the month of June the traffic officer issued or acted upon 30 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 12 parking citations and investigated 0 school bus violation.

As of the last day of June 2021 there were 67 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of the two towing companies, Reed's and Patriot, with 6 in secured storage. Of the 67 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
