- **Housing:** A full rehabilitation has begun for a Massillon Homeowner . Another full rehab has been bid out to contractors. We have two income approved buyers hoping to utilize our First-time home buyers' program. Both approved buyers are in the process of finding their homes. Stark county RPC is continually updated on project status, set ups/completions and request for payment are submitted as necessary. The HOME financial ledger has been updated and maintained.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of June I received 16 fair housing and tenant/landlord calls. We continue to receive calls for individuals looking for rental assistance, or lower income housing. These calls are referred as necessary. We have had calls from individuals living in mobile home parks, these callers are referred to the mobile home association.- We have had complaints of neglected repairs, and questions regarding escrowing rent, and landlords inquiring what to do when a tenant abandons the property.
- **Community Development :** In June a new roof and gutters were installed for a longtime Massillon resident who qualified for emergency assistance. A bathroom modification was also completed this month. We have a minor repair project under way for a homeowner needing a variety of needed repairs. An application was sent to another homeowner with a leaking roof, as well as a homeowner that needs electric updates. We are entering a new program year as well, so many preparations have begun . New income limits for 2023 took effect this month.
- **Administrative:** Manage phone calls. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Updated activities as necessary. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Prepare documents as needed for meetings.

The total income tax receipts posted for June 2023 was \$2,354,957.99. This amount is an increase from June 2022 of \$163,360.68 (+7%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2023 was \$13,226,152.30. Receipts posted for 2023 was a decrease from 2022 of \$407,214.36 (-3%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 71% of all tax collections through the year of 2023. Individual income tax payments represent 15% of all tax collections through the year of 2023 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 14%.

Average monthly income for the six months of 2023 is \$2,204,358.72. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2021 was \$1,925,453.47.

Year to date refunds for 2023 was \$336,368.58 compared to refunds for 2022 of \$318,779.93. Refund difference \$17,588.65 (more refunds in 2023 compared to 2022).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 50.00% for the following accounts for 2023. Account percentages collected for the six months of 2023 are as follows:

In June of 2023, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 134 traffic citations, 60 more than was issued during the same time period last year. This resulted in a total of 180 charges. The Massillon Police Department made 15 arrests for OVI, 4 more than was made in June of 2022. Radar citations for the month totaled 9; this was 4 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 82 traffic accidents during June. This was 9 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 51 property damage accidents, 8 injury accidents, there were 23 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 13 hit skip accidents, and there was 1 accident that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. The Massillon Police Department investigated 4 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 reported injury. There was 0 motorcycle, 0 bicycle, 0 pedestrian, and 4 commercial accidents during the month. There were 0 fatal accident in the city in the month of June.

In June of 2023 there were 73 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 23 more than the number towed in June of 2022. Of the above tows, 34 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 10 for traffic offenses of some type, 18 as a direct result of an arrest, 8 for parking violations. There was 0 recovered stolen vehicle and 3 misc. tows.

During the month of June 2022, the traffic officer mailed 11 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 8 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During June 2023 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 12 motor vehicles. Also during the month of June the traffic officer issued or acted upon 17 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 11 parking citations and investigated 0 school bus violation.

As of the last day of June 2023 there were 64 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of the two towing companies, Reed's and Patriot, with 3 in secured storage. Of the 64 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.

On the 14<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the monthly staff meeting.

Also, on the 14<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Health Department Open House. Congratulations to Director Terri Argent and her staff on a great job renovating the building enabling them to improve an already excellent service to the City.

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Imagine Downtown meeting.

On the 26<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Sequential Intercept Mapping (SIM) Priority Area 4 – Pink Slip group meeting via MS Teams. This is one of the goal-based committees established from the SIM workshop conducted in May by Stark MHAR.

On the 27<sup>th</sup> of the month, I attended the Hazmat Executive Board meeting at the Hazmat Building in Canton.

On the 28<sup>th</sup> of the month, chiefs from Jackson Township Fire Department and I visited Green Fire Department to observe and review their recently installed Bryx Fire Station Alerting System. We have been researching the system over the past nine to twelve months. Back in February, we visited Cuyahoga Falls Fire Department to look at their Bryx System. Work will continue over the next few months to determine if this system would be beneficial to the fire departments and RED Center.

Crews continued their training efforts at the acquired house on 18<sup>th</sup> St. NW. This month they worked on Vent Enter Isolate Search (VEIS). This is a tactic used in certain circumstances to locate and remove trapped occupants.

Crews also completed approximately 90 % of required annual hose testing. To this point, we have experienced only a couple of sections that failed testing. Those sections will either be removed from service or if able, cut to a shorter length, recoupled, and placed back in service.

Asst. Chief Spicocchi and the uniform committee continue to explore possible uniform changes. The current uniform has skyrocketed in price and new data is exposing some safety issues with the material used.

Asst. Chief Rhodes and Captain Castile are researching potential vehicles or trailers to carry our rope rescue and technical rescue equipment.
