From: Anna Jordan-Community Development Coordinator

- **Housing:** The full rehab project is completed, and waiting on lead inspection. Payment request has been made, and RPC updated on project status. We had one application out we never received back, at this time we don't have any other interested homeowners. We have adequate funding for projects, but we have had trouble finding qualifying homes for this specific program. RPC is continually updated on progress of projects using HOME funding. RPC is keeping us updated on HOME policies and procedures as they come. We are looking at possible different projects to fund with available HOME monies. Brochures and income guidelines were updated June 1st.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of June I received 21 calls . This month I assisted tenants and landlords with eviction questions. I received calls regarding extension on eviction notices, and landlords calling for eviction process. We assist with information best we can, but month to month renters , this is a possibility. Received calls from individuals looking for rental assistance, as per usual we supply numbers for resources. We assess calls and determine if a formal fair housing complaint is needed. Some were given information regarding legal aid. We supply as many resources as possible. Zero calls I had involved fair housing. We are prepping for the landlord convention to be held this September, as well as the funfest held in August.
- **Community Development :** In June we reached the end of the 2025 funding year. Our 2026 annual action plan has been submitted. In June, we completed a roof project, and a window replacement project. We currently have an electric/plumbing job in the process, as well as two roof jobs in process, and two awarded to contractors. Another electric job has been bid, and we have received a partial application for a homeowner that needs a new hot water tank. We have several other application packets out to homeowners interested in our program.
- **Administrative:** . Manage phone calls. IDIS activities and projects set up, funded, and updated as necessary. Place ad orders with local paper. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Ledgers balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Prepare documents as needed for meetings. Application packets prepared and mailed. New files set up as needed. Schedule events, prepare flyers etc. Set up pre-construction meetings with contractors.
- **Meetings/Training/Events:** for the month of June I attended the following meetings:

Economic Development

Fielded calls regarding new business opportunities to discuss site location, zoning, and site plan review procedures. Attended NEFCO (Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning & Development Organization) monthly board meeting. Director of Development was appointed by the Stark County Commissioners to serve on this board. Continued working with two (2) parties interested in purchasing and renovation historic downtown buildings for commercial use. Released RFP for CIC for four (4) vacant downtown lots at the corner of Erie St. and LW. Worked with legal counsel for residential developer to discuss TIF options for infrastructure improvements. Met with local company on expansion project and land acquisition. Attended quarterly SEDB meeting. Met with potential business on annexation. Held Site Plan Review Committee Meetings for Nova Storage LLC warehousing units project and Take 5 Oil Change.

Community Development

Continued CDBG administrative duties including accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures, monitoring expenditures for all activities in IDIS, and monitoring of CDBG sub recipients and their programs. Fielded calls from residents regarding the City's vacant land reutilization program and questions regarding zoning requirements for various projects. Worked with code enforcement officers and held weekly status meetings to go over procedures, record keeping, and implementation of the International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC). Several Code cases are being reviewed by the Law Department for prosecution. The City's FY 2026 CDBG allocation was released by HUD. This year's allocation is \$646,246, a \$75 decrease from estimated amount. The City will undertake 4-5 demolition projects this spring. Environmental and historic preservation reviews have been completed. Scheduled asbestos surveys before quotes are sought from demolition contractors. Attended Massillon Main Street meeting to discuss FY 2026 CDBG projects.

Community Outreach Activity Report

June 2026

During June 2026, the Massillon City Health Department Community Outreach Program continued expanding access to essential services, health education, and community resources throughout Massillon.

The **June 16 Pop-Up Pantry** provided food assistance to **222 families** in partnership with the Akron-Canton Regional Foodbank.

Through the **Heart of Ohio Diaper Bank**, Community Outreach served **84 families** with diapers, welcomed **17 new families** into the program, and distributed period products to **25 families**, helping meet essential hygiene needs within our community.

Community Outreach also participated in the **Obie Food Truck Summer Food Program**, engaging with **28 families** to promote Health Department services and community resources. During the event, **6 new families** were connected with information about the Health Department's low-cost sports physical program. Families also received education on tick and mosquito prevention, summer sun safety, and other seasonal health topics. Outreach distributed **12 bottles of Zevo insect repellent**, travel-size sunscreen, and educational materials.

To strengthen outreach efforts and better serve the community, Community Outreach completed **QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) Suicide Prevention Training**, attended the **Health Improvement Summit**, and participated in **Child Safety Training**.

Community Outreach also presented to the **Massillon Lions Club**, highlighting Health Department programs, community partnerships, and resources available to residents. The presentation strengthened relationships with local organizations and increased awareness of services available to Massillon families. We received a check in the amount of \$500 to go towards our food pantry on-site.

Throughout the month, Community Outreach remained committed to building community partnerships, increasing awareness of Health Department programs, and connecting residents with resources that promote the health and well-being of the Massillon community.

The total income tax receipts posted for June 2026 was \$2,804,299.23. This amount is an increase from June 2025 of +8.03%.

Year to date income tax receipts posted through June 2026 was \$14,869,026.46. Receipts posted for 2026 is an increase from 2025 of +5.09%.

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 73% of all tax collections through the year of 2026. Individual income tax payments represent 12% of all tax collections through the year of 2026 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 15%.

Average monthly income for the six months of 2026 is \$2,478,171.08. Average monthly income for the year of 2025 was \$2,227,974.24. Average monthly income for the year of 2024 was \$2,129,262.05.

Year to date refunds for 2026 are \$382,878.76.

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 50.00% for the following accounts for 2026. Account percentages collected for the six months of 2026 are as follows:
