Date: June 14, 2019

The total income tax receipts posted for May 2019 was \$1,713,302.97. This amount is a decrease from May 2018 of \$-767,903.81 (-31%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the first five months 2019 was \$9,553,703.71. Receipts posted for 2019 was an increase from 2018 of \$164,852.46 (2%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 66% of all tax collections through the year of 2019. Individual income tax payments represent 22% of all tax collections through the year of 2019 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 13%.

Average monthly income for the first five months of 2019 is \$1,910,740.75. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2019 was \$134,091.98 compared to refunds for 2018 of \$389,241.65. Refunds difference \$255,149.67 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2019).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 41.67% for the following accounts for 2019. Account percentages collected for the first five months of 2019 are as follows:

## TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT MONTH OF MAY 2019

In May of 2019, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 184 traffic citations, 22 more than was issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 13 arrests for OVI, 4 more than were made in May of 2018. Radar citations for the month totaled 25; this was 8 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 98 traffic accidents during May. This was 20 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 55 property damage accidents, 15 injury accidents, there were 28 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 15 hit skip accidents, and there were 7 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. The Massillon Police Department investigated 11 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 3 reported injuries. There were no motorcycle, bicycle or pedestrian accidents during the month. There were no fatal accidents in the city in the month of May.

In May of 2019 there were 78 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 10 more than the number towed in May of 2018. Of the above tows, 44 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 4 for traffic offenses of some type, 14 as a direct result of an arrest, 15 for parking violations. There was 1 recovered stolen vehicle and no misc. tows.

During the month of May 2019, the traffic officer mailed 30 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 18 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During May 2019 the traffic officer was able to junk or title 17 motor vehicles. Also during the month of May the traffic officer issued or acted upon 43 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 19 parking citations and investigated 1 school bus violation.

As of the last day of May 2019 there were 44 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of the two towing companies, Reed's and Patriot. Of the 44 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
