MONTHLY REPORT: May 2026

From: Anna Jordan-Community Development Coordinator

- **Housing:** The full rehab project is nearly completed. We spoke to contractor who is finishing up the last list items. We have an application out to an interested homeowner , but have not received any documents back yet. We have adequate funding for projects, but we have had trouble finding qualifying homes for this specific program. RPC is continually updated on progress of projects using HOME funding. RPC is keeping us updated on HOME policies and procedures as they come. We are looking at possible different projects to fund with available HOME monies. We received updated income guidelines, that take effect June 1.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of May I received 17 calls . This month I assisted tenants and landlords with eviction questions. Callers wanted more information about lease terms and month to month agreements. We have had calls of long-time residents receiving 30-day notices so that units can be updated and re-rented for higher amounts. We assist with information best we can, but month to month renters , this is a possibility. Received calls from individuals looking for rental assistance, as per usual we supply numbers for resources. We assess calls and determine if a formal fair housing complaint is needed. Some were given information regarding legal aid. We supply as many resources as possible. Zero calls I had involved fair housing. We held our annual fair housing luncheon, with a panel of speakers. Luncheon had a great turn out, and was very informative.
- **Community Development :** In May we completed a furnace install with electric updates. A window job is currently being finished. We are in process of bidding an electric/plumbing job to contractors. We have a roof job in progress, as well as two more that we are preparing for bid. 2026 Annual action plan was submitted. We are updating IDIS as needed, and utilizing CDBG funding to assist homeowners. We continue to process sub recipient requisitions, and reached out to them to remind them that our program year end is quickly approaching. 2026 recipients for CDBG funding were notified.
- **Administrative:** . Manage phone calls. IDIS activities and projects set up, funded, and updated as necessary. Place ad orders with local paper. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. Ledgers balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Prepare documents as needed for meetings. Application packets prepared and mailed. New files set up as needed. Schedule events, prepare flyers etc. Set up pre-construction meetings with contractors.

Economic Development

Fielded calls regarding new business opportunities to discuss site location, zoning, and site plan review procedures. Attended NEFCO (Northeast Ohio Four County Regional Planning & Development Organization) monthly board meeting. Director of Development was appointed by the Stark County Commissioners to serve on this board. Attended the Stark Economic Development Board informational meeting regarding data centers. Held a pre-planning meeting for Babcock & Wilcox hydrogen plant project. Continued working with two (2) parties interested in purchasing and renovation historic downtown buildings for commercial use. Held CIC meeting to approve LWE/Erie St. N. RFP.

Community Development

Continued CDBG administrative duties including accounting and financial management for CDBG expenditures, monitoring expenditures for all activities in IDIS, and monitoring of CDBG sub recipients and their programs. Fielded calls from residents regarding the City's vacant land reutilization program and questions regarding zoning requirements for various projects. Worked with code enforcement officers and held weekly status meetings to go over procedures, record keeping, and implementation of the International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC). Several Code cases are being reviewed by the Law Department for prosecution. Submitted FY 2026 CDBG Annual Action Plan to Stark County Regional Planning Commission for submission to HUD by May 15 deadline. The City's FY 2026 CDBG allocation was released by HUD. This year's allocation is \$646,246, a \$75 decrease from estimated amount. The City will undertake 4-5 demolition projects this spring. Environmental and historic preservation reviews have been completed. Currently waiting on asbestos reports before quotes are sought from demolition contractors.

Sanitary Sewer Replacement Project – Medill, Commonwealth, Wellman. Cavanaugh Construction. Reviewing submittals. Started 1/5/2026. Main line installation is completed on Medill and Commonwealth. Waiting on road restoration. Project complete. Working on punch list items.

STORM SEWERS

Misc Drainage Repairs- CB's repairs, sink holes – Analysis, report, and repairs ongoing.

Tremont Ave SW- Storm Sewer Replacement. MSG Inspection services. United Earthworks 100% complete. Punchlist developed. Asphalt repairs in the Summer 2026.

North Erie Canal/Burton Ave Storm Sewer Replacement –ARPA funds. QBS design. Lockhart Concrete. OHM Inspection. Aqua Ohio relocated the water line. Ongoing. Underground completed 2/27/2026. Community Outreach Activity Report

May 2026

In May 2026, the Massillon City Health Department **Community Outreach Program** continued to focus on connecting residents with food assistance, diaper support, health education, and local community resources.

The May **Pop-Up Pantry** was held on May 19th, 2026, **servicing 224 families** with food assistance through the Akron-Canton Food Bank.

Through the Heart Of Ohio Diaper Bank, as a Community Distribution Site Partner, we **served 77 families, supporting 116 children, and distributed 4,005 diapers/pull ups.**

Community Outreach also participated in several coalition and community partnership meetings, including **Drug Free Stark County, Suicide Prevention, and the Opiate Addictions Task Force** coalition meetings. Working towards a Mental Health toolkit training and providing Male Suicide Prevention posters and hotline numbers to be displayed in local businesses.

We met with the **Stark County Housing Authority** and attended the **Fair Housing Luncheon** at the Eagles in Massillon. Outreach has also participated at **St. Joseph's Pantry** and **City Serve Pantry Café** where **50 outreach care bags** were provided along with Narcan, WIC, gunlocks, vaccine and Mental Health resources were distributed to community members.

In addition, Outreach participated in the **Legacy Project Family night**, providing outreach bags that included information on WIC, the Harm Reduction vending machine, Massillon City Health Department Services, tick prevention, and Deterra medication disposal resources.

Throughout the month, we continued building relationships with Stark County and surrounding-area organizations and businesses by distributing Massillon City Health Department flyers, program information, and community resource materials

The planned panel discussion was well received, as tenants shared their stories of unfair treatment, and fear of retaliation if they reached out for help. The total income tax receipts posted for May 2026 was \$1,667,793.36. This amount is a decrease from May 2025 of -9.78%.

Year to date income tax receipts posted through May 2026 was \$12,064,727.23. Receipts posted for 2026 is an increase from 2025 of +4.67%.

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 75% of all tax collections through the year of 2026. Individual income tax payments represent 14% of all tax collections through the year of 2026 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 11%.

Average monthly income for the five months of 2026 is \$2,412,945.45. Average monthly income for the year of 2025 was \$2,227,974.24. Average monthly income for the year of 2024 was \$2,129,262.05.

Year to date refunds for 2026 are \$382,878.76.

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 41.67% for the following accounts for 2026. Account percentages collected for the five months of 2026 are as follows:
