The total income tax receipts posted for November 2024 was \$1,786,134.21. This amount is an increase from October 2023 of +9.07%.

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2024 was \$23,572,558.71. Receipts posted for 2024 was an increase from 2023 of +4.19%.

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 79% of all tax collections through the year of 2024. Individual income tax payments represent 10% of all tax collections through the year of 2024 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 11%.

Average monthly income for the eleven months of 2024 is \$2,142,959.88. Average monthly income for the year of 2023 was \$2,060,967.62. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75.

Year to date refunds for 2024 was \$520,481.93 (per VIP expense report).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 91.67% for the following accounts for 2024. Account percentages collected for the eleven months of 2024 are as follows:
