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

Code Enforcement Involvement? We continue to work with Code Enforcement who assist us in contacting Landlords. They also check out the complaints of renters and landlords, as it pertains to Reasonable Accommodation.

- **Housing Rehabilitation Projects:** Presently, we are working on two full rehabilitations.
- **Minor Repair** - We were able to finish two Minor Repairs enabling us to provide assistance to homeowners in need of more than one emergency repair. These were inclusive of a roof and electrical, and roof and duct work.
- **Emergency Rehabilitation Projects:** We have assisted a homeowner with a Boiler Repair. Additionally, we repaired a furnace, put in a new furnace, installed a hot water tank, and three roofs in the month of November.
- **FIRST TIME HOMEBUYERS ASSISTED:** Questions: We have two first time homebuyers who began their search in November.
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STATUS OF THOSE WAITING OR PRESENTLY BEING SERVED?: We do have a wait list for Full Rehabilitations and roofs; and continue to be in touch with them to upgrade their status as needed.

The total income tax receipts posted for November 2018 was \$1,268,808.69. This amount is a decrease from November 2017 of \$-12,260.60 (-1%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the eleven months of 2018 was \$18,962,359.85. Receipts posted year to date through the eleven months was an increase from 2017 of \$+57,060.74 (+0.30%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 75% of all tax collections through the year of 2018. Individual income tax payments represent 15% of all tax collections through the year of 2018 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 10%.

Average monthly income for the eleven months of 2018 is \$1,723,850.89. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2018 was \$508,819.65 compared to refunds for 2017 of \$436,697.53. Refunds difference \$72,122.12 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2017).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 91.67% for the following accounts for 2018. Account percentages collected for the eleven months of 2018 are as follows:



TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In November of 2018 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 194 traffic citations, 37 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 16 arrests for OVI, 1 more than in November of 2017. Radar Citations for the month totaled 29 which was 14 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 79 traffic accidents during November. This was 19 less than last year at this time. There were 45 property damage accidents, 21 injury accidents, 13 accidents that occurred on private property, of the above accidents there were 12 hit skip accidents, there were 6 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs during the month. There were 2 pedestrian accidents and no bicycle or motorcycle accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 4 accidents involving juveniles that resulted in 2 injuries. There was 1 fatal accident.

In November 2018 there were 80 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 14 more than were towed in November of 2017. Of the above tows, 42 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 5 for traffic offenses of some type, 17 as a direct result of an arrest and 16 for parking violations. There were no stolen/recovered vehicles or misc. tows. The traffic officer issued 13 parking citations and investigated 1 school bus violation during the month.

During the month of November 2018 the traffic officer was able to mail 21 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer submitted 13 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During November the traffic officer was able to junk or title 15 motor vehicles. Also during the month of November the traffic officer issued or acted upon 35 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of November 2018 there were 71 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 71 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them. .
