2019 Catch Basin Replacement Project II- Bid opening August 1st, 2019, begin September 16th. Awarded to Holderbaum. Complete.

Burton Ave NW - Evaluating flooding and resolutions. Fixed catchbasin at 26 Burton driveway. Weir at 1st St NE in Spring 2020.

Curb installed June 12<sup>th</sup>. Asphalt installed June 24<sup>th</sup>. Working on a few punch list items. Plat recorded on September 6<sup>th</sup>. Roadway is open and in use.

<u>Westbrook Estates Phase IV</u> – Preliminary plat approved by Planning Commission May 13, 2015. Construction plans approved. Final plat approved by Planning Commission on January 13, 2016 and Council on February 16, 2016. Construction is complete.

Subject: Income Tax Monthly Report -November 2019

Date: December 12, 2019

The total income tax receipts posted for November 2019 was \$1,473,501.38. This amount is an increase from November 2018 of \$204,692.69 (16%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the eleven months of 2019 was \$19,177,645.84. Receipts posted for 2019 was an increase from 2018 of \$215,285.99 (1%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 72% of all tax collections through the year of 2019. Individual income tax payments represent 15% of all tax collections through the year of 2019 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 13%.

Average monthly income for the eleven months of 2019 is \$1,770,414.45. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2019 was \$357,811.26 compared to refunds for 2018 of \$508,819.65. Refunds difference \$151,008.39 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2019).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 91.67% for the following accounts for 2019. Account percentages collected for the eleven months of 2019 are as follows:

The department responded to 468 alarms during the month. This averages to 15.6 alarms per day. There were 90 fire alarm and public service calls, and 378 rescue and EMS calls. There were no fatalities or injuries due to fire.

On the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, Aultman Massillon Emergency Room opened. The Massillon/Mckinley game pep rally-parade-and bonfire also took place.

On the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of the month, the department conducted monthly EMS Continuing Education.

On the 7th of the month, I attended the regular monthly LOGIC Board meeting.

On the 13<sup>th</sup> of the month, Beau Boswell completed probation and was appointed to the department as a firefighter/paramedic.

On the 14th of the month, I participated in the LOGIC Board negotiations.

On the 23<sup>rd</sup> of the month, the department participated in the annual Holiday Parade. This year, there were fireworks as part of the celebration.

- Housing: One Full rehabilitation applicant has been approved, spec sheets for electric, plumbing and furnace work have been sent to the county, and we are waiting on appraisal so we can begin next step. Another applicant is still in the verification phase. We provided down payment for a new Massillon homeowner in November, 2 more homeowners completed applications for assistance with down payment in the month of November.
- Fair Housing: For the month of November I received 13 fair housing calls. Callers included both tenants and landlords. Code enforcement was involved in many of these calls, and we worked together to help a lot of tenants get repairs done on homes to improve standard of living, as well as educate landlords in the process.
- Community Development: We successfully completed 2 roof rehabs and 2 new furnaces to Massillon residents through our Emergency Assistance Program. We currently have 2 more roof projects under way, and 1 currently out for bid. We held the 2020FY block grant application workshop to inform potential applicants on details when applying, and minor changes when submitting for reimbursements next year. We updated them on criteria for documenting individuals that receive assistance through their programs, in hopes that our monitoring will be more accurate and detailed as well.
- NIP: At the Land Bank meeting this month, we were updated on the reimbursements expected for submitted applications.
- Administrative: Prepared and paid bills/did IDIS drawdowns for funds. Ledger balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month.

# TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2019

In November of 2019, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 124 traffic citations, 70 fewer traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 15 arrests for OVI, 1 less than was made in November of 2018. Radar Citations for the month totaled 14, this was 15 less than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 95 traffic accidents during November. That was 16 more accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 60 property damage accidents, 11 injury accidents, there were 24 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 10 hit skip accidents, and there were 13 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 1 bicycle and no pedestrian accidents during the month. There were no motorcycle accident during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 8 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 reported injury. There were no fatal accidents.

In November of 2019 there were 85 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 5 more than were towed in November 2018. Of the above tows, 36 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 6 for traffic offenses of some type, 24 as a direct result of an arrest, and 17 for parking violations. There was 1 stolen/recovered vehicle and 1 miscellaneous tow.

During the month of November 2019 the Traffic Officer mailed 24 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The Traffic Officer made 18 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During November 2019 the Traffic Officer was able to junk or title 16 motor vehicles. Also during the month of November, the Traffic Officer issued or acted upon 31 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices), issued 6 Parking Summons, investigated 0 school bus violations and conducted 1 garbage truck inspection. The Traffic Officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The Traffic Officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of November 2019 there were 47 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 47 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them. 3 vehicles are being held in secured storage.
