Subject: Income Tax Monthly Report –November 2020

Date: December 3, 2020

The total income tax receipts posted for November 2020 was \$1,490,908.98. This amount is an increase from November 2019 of \$+17,407.60 (+1%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the eleven months of 2020 was \$18,570,688.46. Receipts posted for 2020 was a decrease from 2019 of \$-606,957.38 (-3%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 74% of all tax collections through the year of 2020. Individual income tax payments represent 14% of all tax collections through the year of 2020 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 12%.

Average monthly income for the eleven months of 2020 is \$1,688,244.40. Average monthly income for the year of 2019 was \$1,758,409.86. Average monthly income for the year of 2018 was \$1,740,903.69.

Year to date refunds for 2020 was \$346,275.99 compared to refunds for 2019 of \$357,811.26. Refunds difference \$11,535.27 (more in refunds 2019 compared to 2020).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 91.67% for the following accounts for 2020. Account percentages collected for the ten months of 2020 are as follows:



TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

In November of 2020, the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 141 traffic citations, 17 more traffic citations than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 12 arrests for OVI, 3 less than was made in November of 2019. Radar Citations for the month totaled 19, this was 4 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 77 traffic accidents during November. That was 18 less accidents than occurred last year during the same time period. There were 52 property damage accidents, 8 injury accidents, there were 17 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents there were 11 hit skip accidents, and there were 2 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 1 bicycle and no pedestrian accidents during the month. There were no motorcycle accident during the month. There were 3 accidents involving commercial motor vehicles during this month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 5 accidents involving juveniles resulting in 1 reported injury. There were no fatal accidents.

In November of 2020 there were 73 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 12 less than were towed in November 2019. Of the above tows, 38 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 12 for traffic offenses of some type, 13 as a direct result of an arrest, and 10 for parking violations. There was 2 stolen/recovered vehicle and 0 miscellaneous tow.

During the month of November 2020 the Traffic Officer mailed 50 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The Traffic Officer made 40 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During November 2020 the Traffic Officer was able to junk or title 32 motor vehicles. Also during the month of November, the Traffic Officer issued or acted upon 25 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices), issued 9 Parking Summons, investigated 2 school bus violations and conducted 0 garbage truck inspection. The Traffic Officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The Traffic Officer logged and filed several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners.

As of the last day of November 2020 there were 64 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's and Patriot Towing Services. Of the 47 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them. 3 vehicles are being held in secured storage.
