The total income tax receipts posted for October 2018 was \$1,427,693.53. This amount is a decrease from October 2017of \$-77,953.67(-5%).

Year to date income tax receipts posted through the ten months of 2018 was \$17,693,551.16. Receipts posted year to date through the ten months was an increase from 2017 of \$+69,321.34 (0.39%).

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 74% of all tax collections through the year of 2018. Individual income tax payments represent 16% of all tax collections through the year of 2018 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 10%.

Average monthly income for the ten months of 2018 is \$1,769,355.11. Average monthly income for the year of 2017 was \$1,734,942.16.

Year to date refunds for 2018 was \$461,157.08 compared to refunds for 2017of \$341,944.32. Refunds difference \$119,212.76 (more in refunds 2018 compared to 2017).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 83.33% for the following accounts for 2018. Account percentages collected for the ten months of 2018 are as follows:

# TRAFFIC ACTIVITY REPORT

# **MONTH OF OCTOBER 2018**

In October of 2018 the Massillon Police Department issued a total of 222 traffic citations, 70 more than were issued during the same time period last year. The Massillon Police Department made 18 arrests for OVI, this was 2 more than last year. Radar citations for the month totaled 26, this was 18 more than last year during the same time period.

The Massillon Police Department handled a total of 96 traffic accidents during October. This was 15 more than last year at this time. There were 54 property damage accidents, 19 injury accidents and no fatal accidents. There were 23 accidents that occurred on private property. Of the above accidents, there were 12 hit skip accidents. There were 3 accidents that occurred as a direct result of alcohol and/or drugs. There was 1 motorcycle accident and no pedestrian or bicycle accidents during the month. The Massillon Police Department investigated 15 accidents involving juveniles that resulted in 3 injuries.

In October 2018 there were 93 motor vehicles towed by the Massillon Police Department. This was 20 more than were towed in October 2017. Of the above tows, 53 vehicles were towed from traffic accidents, 21 as a direct result of an arrest, 12 for parking violations and 6 for traffic offenses of some type. There were no miscellaneous tows and 1 recovered stolen vehicle was towed during the month.

During the month of October 2018, the traffic officer mailed 34 certified letters in regards to junk and/or abandoned motor vehicles. The traffic officer made 23 title searches to the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles. During October 2018, the traffic officer was able to junk or title 26 motor vehicles. Also during the month of October the traffic officer issued or acted upon 26 notices (48/72 hour and/or 10/20 day notices). The traffic officer further sent numerous 2255's and driver's licenses to the state. The traffic officer logged, and filed, several license plates, and kept track of the motor vehicles awaiting court order for immobilization, confiscation or return to the owners. The traffic officer issued 7 parking citations and investigated 1 school bus violation.

As of the last day of October 2018, there were 72 motor vehicles sitting upon the impound lots of Reed's Incorporated and Patriot Towing Service. Of the 72 vehicles, several are waiting for court order to dispose of them.
