MONTHLY REPORT: October 2024.

From: Anna Jordan-Community Development Coordinator

- **Housing:** We currently have two applicants for the full rehab program. One application was just received, the other is income approved, and going through the inspection process. A third interested homeowner was mailed an application packet. A homeowner was income approved, but inspection was well over the full rehab maximum allowance. These applicants will receive assistance for one item through another program. HOME handbook and documents are being updated to better meet HUDS guidelines as well.
- **Fair Housing:** For the month of October, I received 23 calls. Calls regarding housing issues, landlord/tenant issues. Renters continue to experience rent increases, and are calling looking for assistance for rent/deposit. Many callers looking for housing, or housing with lower rents. We supply as many resources as possible. Majority of calls are tenants complaining of neglected repairs at their homes. Calls will be referred out as necessary. We have set up a fair housing board meeting for November.
- **Community Development :** We are very busy with our rehab programs currently. We have homeowners approved for roofing assistance, electric repair, bathroom modifications, plumbing assistance and furnace replacement. We have other applications submitted as well, and continue to receive calls from interested homeowners.
- Sub-recipient contracts are being executed, and IDIS projects and activities are being set up and updated with accomplishments. CDBG ledger is being updated for the new year. We have also been updating handbooks, and documents for the CDBG funded programs.
- **Administrative:** Manage phone calls. IDIS activities and projects set up, funded, and updated as necessary. Prepared and paid bills/ IDIS drawdowns for funds. New purchase orders for our funding year have been prepared. Ledgers balanced and maintained accurately throughout the month. Other tasks upon assignment. Supplies ordered as needed. RPC set up and completions completed in a timely manner. Prepare documents as needed for meetings. Application packets prepared and mailed. New files set up as needed.

Community Development

Fielded calls from residents regarding the City's vacant land reutilization program and questions regarding zoning requirements for various projects. Initiated two property transfers through the City's vacant land program.

Worked with code enforcement officers and held weekly status meetings to go over procedures, record keeping, and legislation updates.

Submitted legislation to City Council to adopt the International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC) to improve effectiveness and efficiency of code enforcement operations.

Submitted City's response to HUD Finding Letter based on the monitoring from the spring. Date: November 5, 2024

The total income tax receipts posted for October 2024 was \$2,034,098.68. This amount is a decrease from October 2023 of -6.25%.

Year to date income tax receipts posted through 2024 was \$21,773,874.34. Receipts posted for 2024 was an increase from 2023 of +4.11%.

Payroll tax withheld by Massillon employers represents 78% of all tax collections through the year of 2024. Individual income tax payments represent 10% of all tax collections through the year of 2024 and Net Profit income tax payments represent 12%.

Average monthly income for the ten months of 2024 is \$2,177,387.43. Average monthly income for the year of 2023 was \$2,060,967.62. Average monthly income for the year of 2022 was \$2,012,420.75.

Year to date refunds for 2024 was \$495,748.58 (per VIP expense report).

Target budget from Auditor's Revenue Report is 83.33% for the following accounts for 2024. Account percentages collected for the ten months of 2024 are as follows:
